At a meeting yesterday in McCarthy I was asked the following R.O.W. questions:

- 1) Does the State maintain that it has a right-of-way through the Kennicott mill site unit?
- 2) If so, what width?
- 3) If so, how is this consistent with declarations within Great Kennicott Land Conveyances. (Note: Kennicott land maintains the route is private and limits easements to forty feet.)

Also note the area in question appears to have been the farthest reach of the old rail bed.
