RE	Permission to Construct, Access and Maintain Pressure Monitoring Service and Equipment		

Permission is hereby granted to the Interior Alaska Gas Utility dba as IGU, its contractors or agents, to enter upon land owned by _____, and described as follows: Lot ??, Block??, of Subdivision??? for the purposes of constructing a 1” service line and installing a telemetry unit for the purposes of monitoring the distribution system pressure by standard approved methods and to bring onto said lands necessary equipment for that purpose and to do those reasonable acts necessary to the accomplishment thereof. The land owner will provide the use of electricity (110/120 v) in a heated environment above 40 degrees F. The land owner understands that the service line and equipment will remain the property of IGU, will allow IGU to have the right to access these company owned facilities at all reasonable time, including the right to ingress to and egress from the land owners’ property. When natural gas becomes available, it is the intention of IGU, that this service will remain in place and serve this property at no additional cost to the land owner for this service line, as well as the installation of an Excess Flow Valve (for single family residential customers only, as required by Federal Pipeline Safety Regulations 49CFR 192.383) and the meter. At the time gas becomes available, the land owner will be required to fill out and sign an application for Natural Gas Service Connection before the meter will be installed.
