Anchorage 053731 Cancelled - Combined with Anchorage 053724
Lands Proper for Selection
Tentative Approval Given

On January 24, 1961, the State of Alaska filed selection application Anchorage 053724 for certain lands in the east half of Township 10 North, Range 1 East, Seward Meridian, and on the same date filed selection application Anchorage 053731 for certain lands in the west half of said township. The combined area of these two applications represents all available lands in this township and, as a township is considered an acceptable area for selection and survey, the two applications are hereby combined to form a compact area for which a boundary survey will be executed. Anchorage 053731 is hereby cancelled, and the lands will be processed under Anchorage 053724.

The selected lands:

Township 10 North, Range 1 East, Seward Meridian

Sections 1 thru 24: All
 Sections 29 and 30: All

✓ excluding Public Land Order 797,

containing approximately 13,900.00 acres, as shown on approved protraction sheet 314-4, officially filed September 12, 1960, meet the criteria for compactness; are unreserved; are not known to be occupied or appropriated under the public land laws, including the mining laws; are not valuable for hot or medicinal springs; and otherwise conform to the requirements of the Act.

In view of the foregoing, the lands are considered proper for acquisition by the State and the selection is hereby tentatively approved. Patent to the State will issue after the lands are officially surveyed.

When the lands are patented to the State, the patent will contain a reservation for canals and ditches under the Act of August 30, 1890 (26 Stat. 391); a reservation to the United States of a right-of-way for the construction of railroads, telegraph and telephone lines under the Act of March 12, 1914 (38 Stat. 305); and a reservation for the life of timber sale contract Anchorage, 029714, covering a portion of Section 6 as shown on the enclosed status plat, issued to Bird Creek Lumber Company under authority of the Act of July 31, 1947 (61 Stat. 681).

Enclosed is a status plat of protracted T. 10 N., R. 1 E., S.M.
