
Dear Chuck:

In accordance with our conversation yesterday in your office, we will adopt the following procedures for issuing Alyeska notice to proceed on highway construction north of the Yukon River.

Alyeska will direct all requests to my attention at the Department of Highways. After we have reviewed their request, we will prepare a letter which, in effect, will be a notice to proceed, subject of course to whatever stipulations we deem should be imposed. After we have carefully reviewed all their plans, we will forward this letter to you for endorsement and delivery to Alyeska. At this point you may add any additional stipulations or communicate with us should you have any problem areas concerning this matter.

After things get started I will probably delegate this authority to the Interior District but for the time being at least we should operate on the basis of all applications coming through my office.
