
Dear Mr. Therrell:

Receipt of your letter of March 9, 1974 and attachments in which you requested a Notice to Proceed for Segments 1 through 7 of the Yukon River to Prudhoe Bay State Highway is acknowledged. We are reviewing your various submittals and you may expect to receive certain design approvals and Notices to Proceed within several days.

In your letter you requested our advice that we had secured all necessary rights-of-way across State, Federal and private lands as provided in the Construction Agreement. Please be advised that we have a right-of-way for the highway across all Federal and State lands involved. We direct your attention to the language in the agreement whereby Alyeska agreed to furnish us plats of any rights-of-ways required across private lands. As we have received no such plats we can only assume that there are no private lands involved.

All requests for material sites and access roads on Federal lands have been filed with the U. S. Bureau of Land Management. To date none of them have been approved however. We will notify you promptly of any approvals as we receive them. The twenty applications for material sources and access roads on State lands will be filed shortly and we expect their approval within several days.
