
Dear Mr. Rollins:

Your letter of April 1, 1974 concerning the issuing of a highway right-of-way and airport leases has been referred to me by Governor Egan.

As we discussed in your office at our last meeting, the State does not feel that we need a highway right-of-way permit for the construction of this road. The circuit court's decision concerning the trans-Alaska pipeline and its attendant facilities, we feel, answers this question quite clearly. We are continuing to review the proposed lease and will correspond with you further if our position in this matter should change.

Commissioner of Public Works Taggart will be writing you concerning the airport leases. If you should wish to meet with Commissioner Taggart and me concerning this matter, we would be pleased to do so.
