We are please to acknowledge receipt of your grant of an easement for a right-of-way for the Yukon to Prudhoe Bay highway issued pursuant to the Trans-Alaska Pipeline Authorization Act and in accordance with the agreement of January 8, 1974, between the State of Alaska and the Department of the Interior and the applicable stipulations incorporated in that agreement.

We understand and appreciate the desirability of making the grant under the Pipeline Authorization Act, and we accept it accordingly. Nevertheless, our acceptance of the grant should in no way be construed as relinquishing, impairing or otherwise diminishing the right-of-way to the same route which we acquired under RS 2477, 43 U.S.C. sec. 932.
