> Campbell, in reading a recent report of weekly coordination meetings, contacted me on two points. He wanted to reassure me that he felt the state's surveillance coverage of the completion of the state highway north of the Yukon was adequate. He has recently driven the entire road and felt that the need for a higher level of surveillance had passed. He feels that the two people remaining--Lane north of the pass and Politka south of the pass--are adequate to supervise the remaining highway construction.

His second point concerned access to the haul road north of the Yukon this coming winter. His interpretation is that the state does not own the road presently, and that he would like to leave the control of access to the road with Alyeska. He made the point that he thought that Alyeska had a good means for such control now because of the Yukon crossing. He expressed himself as wishing to watch what the developments were and not take any overt actions until necessary. We discussed the differences in the situation of last winter's operations with this coming winter's, and
