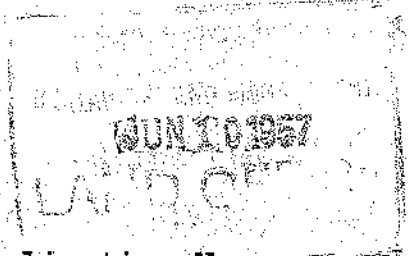

do hereby apply to have allotted to me under the act of May 17, 1906 (34 Stat., 197), the <sup>1</sup> following described land:

Beginning at a point located South 25°35' E., 11.55 chains from U. S. Land Monument #434A; thence West 1,014.42 feet along the north boundary of the San Dennis Allotment to a point; thence North 2,000 feet to a point; thence East to the Chilkeet River; thence Southeasterly following the westerly bank of the Chilkeet River to the mean high tideline along Lutak Islet; thence Southeasterly following the mean high tideline along Lutak Islet to a point due East of the point of beginning; thence West 135.96 feet to the point of beginning.
