MUTUAL AGREEMENT FOR USE OF EASEMENT

The undersigned, grantors and grantees, do hereby agree, that a certain strip of land, 30 feet wide and 375 feet long, more particularly described at another place in this agreement, shall be available for use as an aircraft runway, for vehicle traffic, and for pedestrian use.

Signatories agree to refrain from impeding normal ingress and egress necessary for full and complete use of said strip of land.

Situated in T.25., R.2E., F.M., and beginning at a point 25 feet East of South 1/4 corner of Section 5 and North 1/4 corner of Section 8, thence East on said Section line 375 feet to a point. A strip of land, 15 feet wide and 375 feet long, on each side of a straight line, connecting these two points, shall be the easement area for mutual use as afore described.

To have and to hold said easement agreement privileges, for ourselves, our assigns and successors forever.

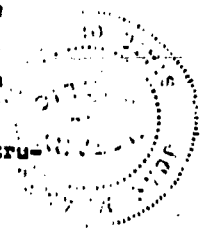
