NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, unto the above-named corporation the surface estate in the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said estate with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said corporation, its successors and assigns, forever.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES from the lands so granted:

- The subsurface estate therein, and all rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, accruing unto said estate pursuant to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971, 43 U.S.C. § 1613(f); and
- 2. Pursuant to Sec. 17(b) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971, 43 U.S.C. § 1616(b), and the administrative record, including easement memoranda, the following public easements, referenced by Easement Identification Number (EIN) on the easement maps, copies of which can be found in the Bureau of Land Management's public land records, are reserved to the United States. All easements are subject to applicable Federal, State, or Municipal corporation regulation. The following is a listing of uses allowed for each type of easement. Any uses which are not specifically listed are prohibited.

<u>25 Foot Trail</u> - The uses allowed on a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement are: travel by foot, dogsleds, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheeled vehicles, and small all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) (less than 3,000 lbs. Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW)).

<u>50 Foot Trail</u> - The uses allowed on a fifty (50) foot wide trail easement are: travel by foot, dogsleds, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheeled vehicles, small and

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large all-terrain vehicles (ATV's), tracked vehicles and fourwheel-drive vehicles.

<u>One Acre Site</u> - The uses allowed on a site easement are: vehicle parking (e.g., aircraft, boats, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's), snowmobiles, cars, trucks), temporary camping, and loading or unloading. Temporary camping, loading, or unloading shall be limited to 24 hours.

- a. (EIN 1 C3, C5, D1, D9) An easement for an existing access trail twenty-five (25) feet in width from Sec. 36, T. 25 N., R. 24 W., Kateel River Meridian, northwesterly to Sec. 32 T. 29 N., R. 27 W., Kateel River Meridian. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement. The season of use will be limited to winter only.
- b. (EIN 16 C5, D9) An easement for an existing access trail twentyfive (25) feet in width from Sec. 21, T. 27 N., R. 26 W., Kateel River Meridian, easterly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement.
- c. (EIN 20 C5) An easement fifty (50) feet in width for an access trail beginning on the left bank of the Kivalina River in Sec. 31, T. 29 N., R. 24 W., Kateel River Meridian, and proceed northeasterly then southerly to public lands. The uses allowed are those listed above for a fifty (50) foot wide trail easement.
- d. (EIN 21 C5) A site easement one (1) acre in size located above the mean high water line, on the left bank of the Kivalina River, in Sec. 31, T. 29 N., R. 24 W., Kateel River Meridian. The uses allowed are those listed above for a site easement.

THE GRANT OF THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED LANDS IS SUBJECT TO:

 Valid existing rights therein, if any, including but not limited to those created by any lease, contract, permit, right-of-way, or easement, and the right of the lessee, contractee, permittee or grantee to the complete enjoyment of all rights, privileges, and benefits thereby granted to him. Further, pursuant to Sec. 17(b)(2) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (ANCSA), 43 U.S.C. § 1616(b)(2), any valid existing right recognized by ANCSA shall continue to have whatever right of access as is now provided for under existing law;

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- 2. The terms and conditions of the granted easement, IC No. 1759, issued on August 28, 1998 to NANA Regional Corporation, Inc. as per the "Terms and Conditions Governing Legislative Land Consolidation and Exchange Between NANA Regional Corporation, Inc., and the United States of America"; and
- 3. Requirements of Sec. 14(c) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971, 43 U.S.C. § 1613(c), as amended, that the grantee hereunder convey those portions, if any, of the lands hereinabove granted, as are prescribed in said section;
 - IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat. 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
