On October 27, 1958, Mr. Elbridge B. Walker filed a Notice of Location for a homestead on what would be when surveyed the $W\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33 and the $E\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 1 N., R. 4 E., F. M.. On January 30, 1961, after the survey marker for the section corner common to Sections 28, 29, 32, and 33 had been set in the ground, Mr. Walker filed an Application for Amendment of claim, amending the claim to the land described as follows:

Beginning at the section corner common to Sections 28, 29, 32, 33, T. 1 N., R. 4 E., F. M. (surveyed on the ground, but not yet approved); thence, east 660 feet to the true point of beginning, corner no. 1; thence, north 460 feet to corner no. 2; thence, west 2310 feet to corner no. 3; thence, south 3100 feet to corner no. 4; thence, east 2310 feet to corner no. 5; thence, north 2640 feet to corner no. 1, the point of beginning; containing 164.40 acres, more or less.

The land described on the cover sheet of this report is the majority of that included in the above metes-and-bounds description. Since the land has been surveyed on-the-ground, it is felt the "what will be when surveyed" description should more properly be used; also, the description on the cover sheet exceeds the 160-acre limitation only one-half an acre, while the metes-and-bounds description exceeds it by 4.40 acres. The one-half acre excess is allowable by the Rule of Approximation.

On July 10, 1961, Mr. Walker filed his final proof.

IDENTIFICATION OF LAND:

The subject land was identified with reference to the north and east section lines of Section 32, T. 1 N., R. 4 E., F. M. as shown on the unapproved plat of T. 1 N., R. 4 E., F. M.. The land generally is sloping to the south, and has a cover of aspen on the north portion, and spruce further down to the south.

INVESTIGATION:

Investigation disclosed 20 acres of cultivation, mostly located in what will be the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32; a small portion of the cultivation is located in what will be the $S\frac{1}{2} S\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29. It appears that Mr. Walker grew oats on this cultivation. Mr. Walker did not cultivate 1/16 of the subject land during his

second year, and has applied for a reduction of cultivation accordingly. The reason stated for not performing any cultivation during his second year was that he had a fire burning on his field all summer until the rains in August put out the fire. Discussions with Guy Lindsey and Bob Longwith, both of the immediate area, indicated that in 1959 Mr. Walker had his 20-acre field sheared of timber, but was afraid to burn it, as the summer was very dry, and a nearby wildfire (Flat Creek Dome Fire) had everybody in Two Rivers worried about fire. Accordingly, Mr. Walker waited until the next summer (1960) to burn. At this time he did, but his fire got out of control and, as he stated, it burned until the fall rains put out the fire; it was then too late to plant, so he waited until the summer of 1961. The dry summer of 1959 is well remembered by this writer; likewise the Flat Creek Dome Fire. It would appear that Mr. Walker's reasons are valid for not cultivating during 1960. As well as the preceding, Mr. Walker, being a veteran with over 19 months of military service, could substitute up to two years of military credit for cultivation, so in this case it might properly be assumed that military credit was substituted for the required cultivation in 1960, his second year.

As stated above, Mr. Walker is a veteran with over 19 months of military service. As such, he needed to reside on the subject land for only seven months in one year. Mr. Walker claims residence from January 31, 1959 to June 27, 1960, 17 months. This residence claim was supported by Don Roberts, Guy Lindsey, and Bob Longwith, all of the Two Rivers area.

Mr. Walker has a frame house 24' x 24' and a frame garage 16' x 16', both located on what will be the $S\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29.

CONCLUSIONS:


Mr. Walker has placed a habitable house on the subject land, he has resided on the subject land in excess of seven months in one year, and he has cultivate 1/8 of the subject land during the third year. He did not cultivate 1/16 of the subject land during the second year, but both due to military credit and actual matters beyond his control as stated on his application for a reduction in acreage, it appears this requirement may be waived.

It would appear Mr. Walker has met the requirements for patent of the subject land, as set forth in 43 CFR 166.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended the final proof of Mr. Elbridge B. Walker be approved.

It is further recommended that the subject land located in what will be Section 28 be reduced to the aliquot-part described as the $S\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$ and that the subject land lying in what will be Section 29 be reduced to what will be when surveyed the $S\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$, the $S\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}N\frac{1}{2}S\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$, and the $SE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$. The reductions in acreage in Sections 28 and 29 bring the total acreage down to 160.5 acres. Although this is still in excess of the 160 acre limitation, using the Rule of Approximation, it is permissible.

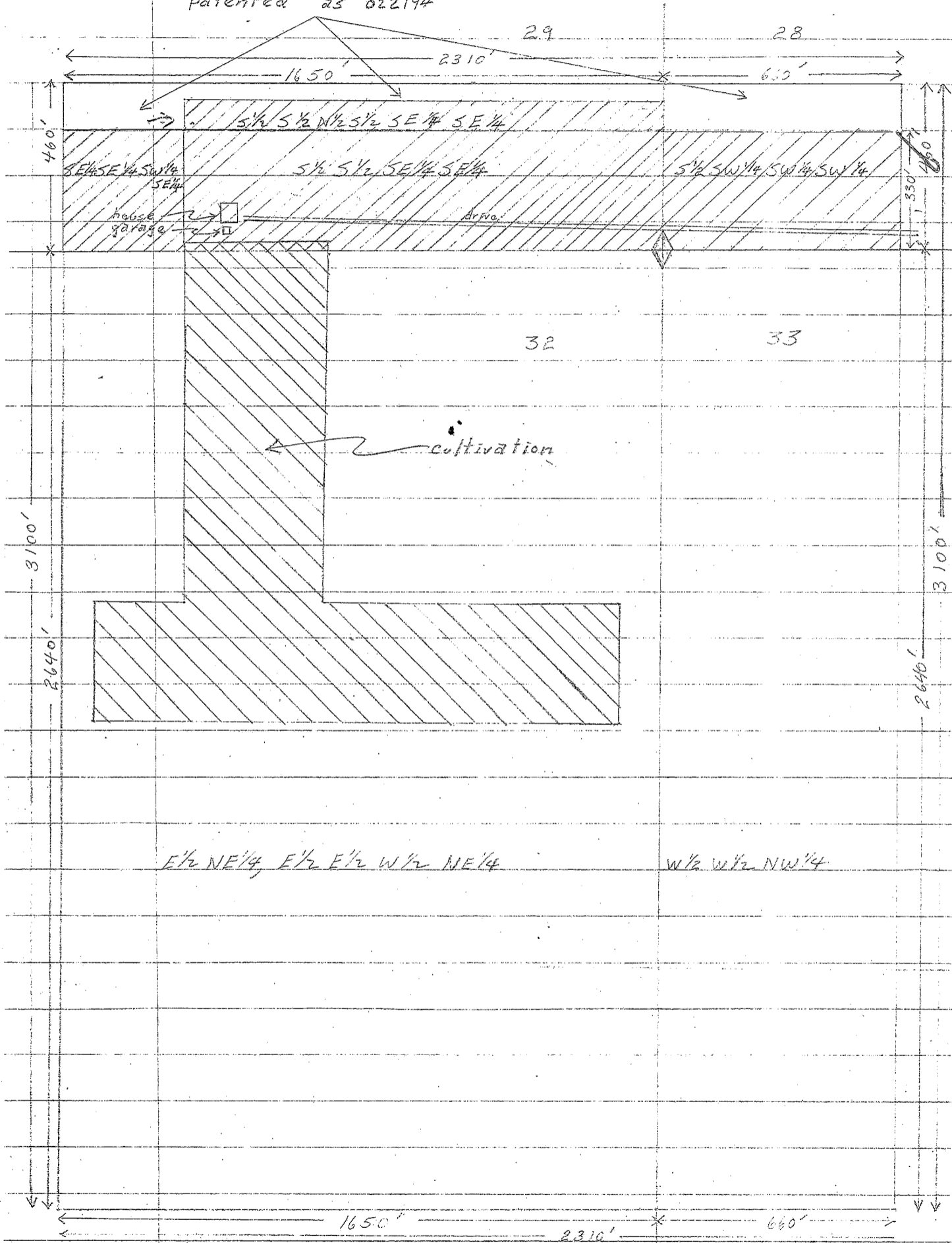

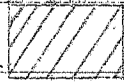

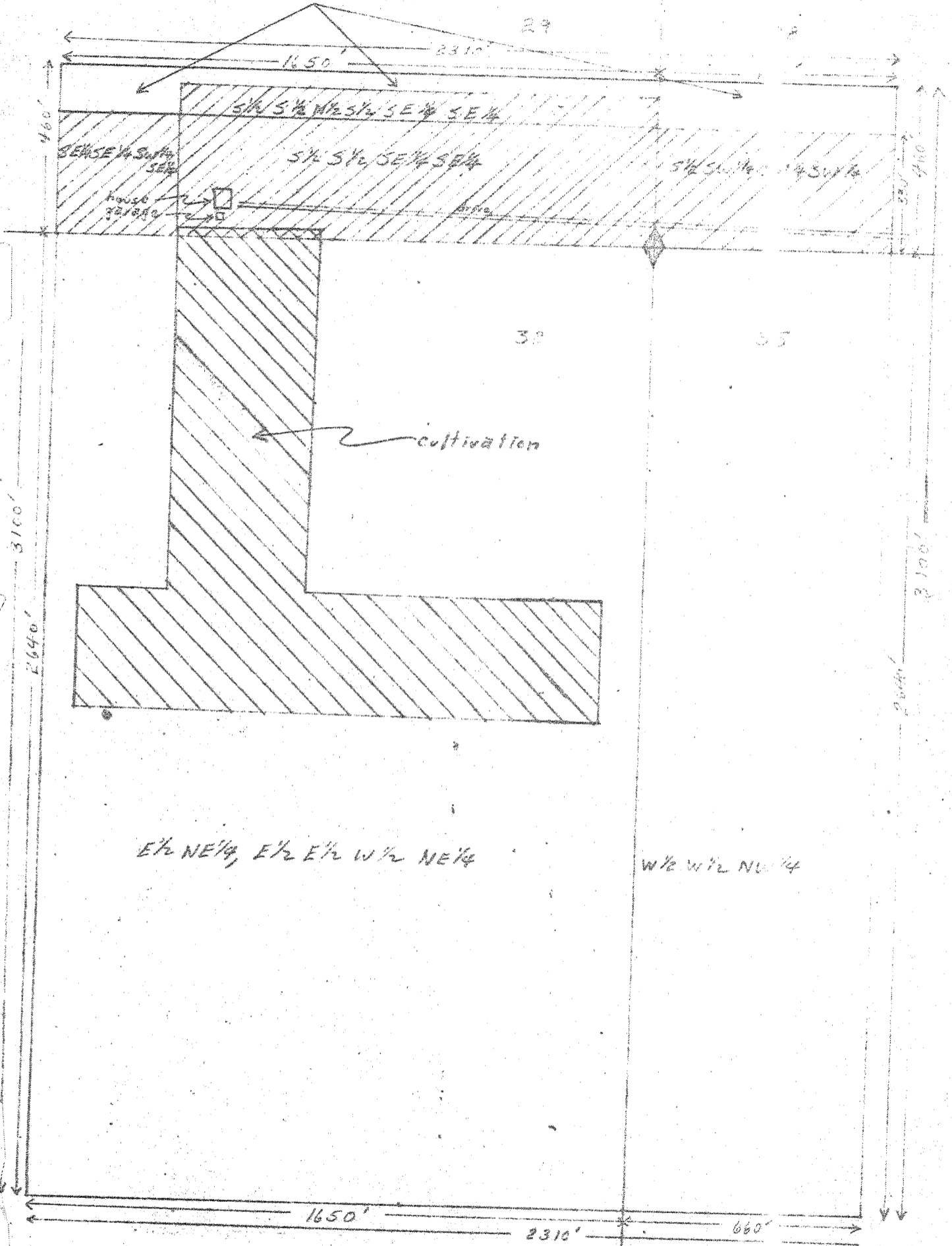


Area recommended patented in sections 28 & 29 as 022194



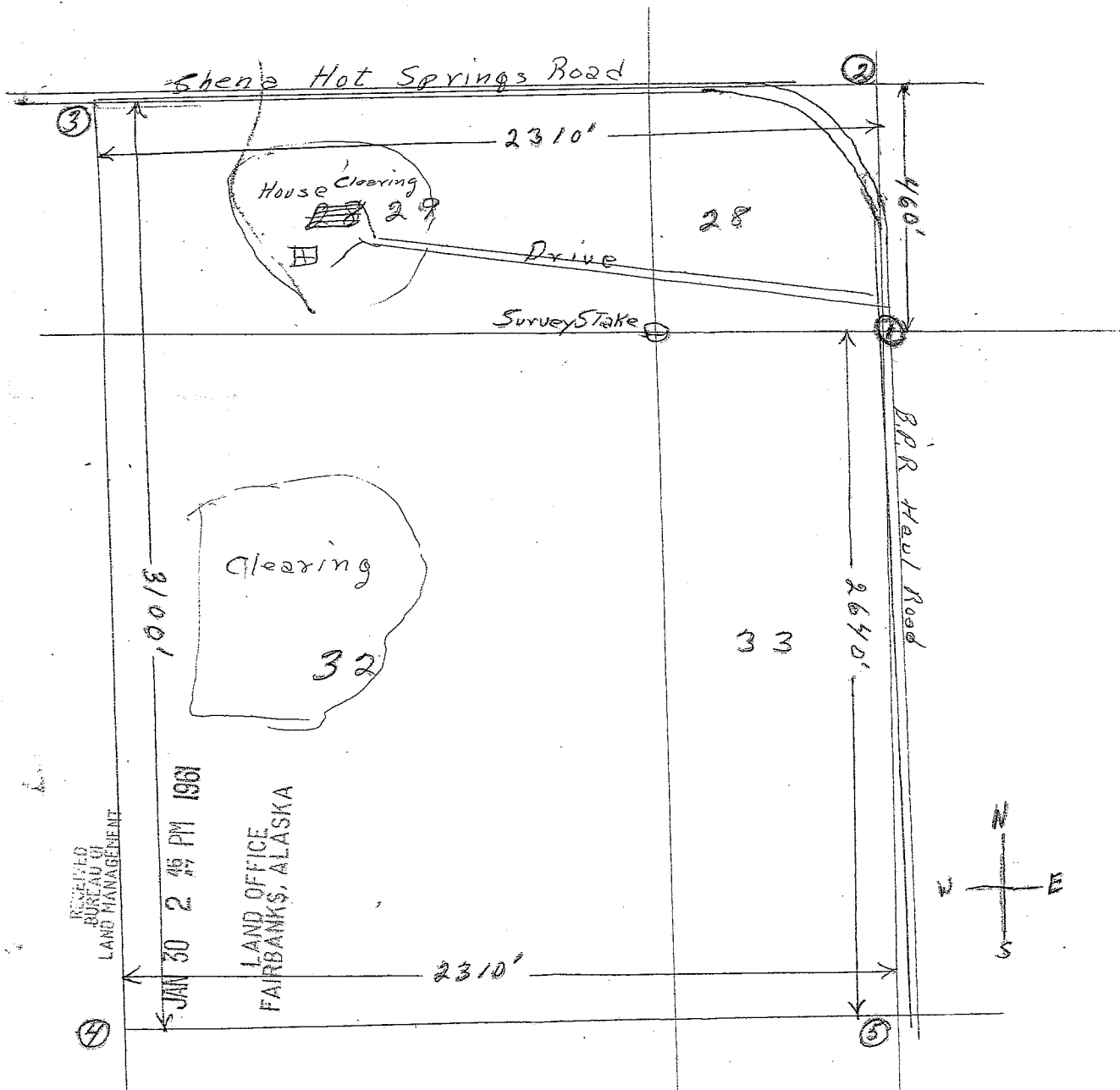
