*The Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge (NMWR) is not completely depicted. Areas where it is depicted are shaded red; they are not outlined. The Alaska Maritime NMWR is described as follows:*

The refuge is generally depicted on the USGS map entitled, "Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge", dated October 1979.
