Final Inspection and Contract  
of State Land Access Road  
Contracts at Benka Lake, Alaska  
Subdivision

On August 25, 1965, a final inspection was made of the following contracts:

1. Contract No. ARCC-20-S24N4W. Said contract being for the right-of-way clearing and grubbing of approximately 2.4 acres of access roads in the subject subdivision. This was a negotiated contract with a lump sum price of \$980.00 in land credit certificates.
2. Contract No. ARCC-21-S24N4W. Said contract being for the grading and drainage of approximately 2590 linear feet of state land access roads in the subject subdivision. This was a negotiated contract with a lump sum cost of \$820.00 in land credit certificates.

These contracts having been satisfactorily completed according to the contract documents and specifications provide a gravel base, all weather road which terminates at a boat launching site on Benka Lake.

I hereby recommend that Don H. Clark & Son Construction be paid an amount of \$1800.00 in land credit certificates. Mr. Clark stated that for payment he would like 18 \$100 certificates. At such time as these certificates are ready, Mr. Clark will come into the office and pick them up.
