Ester Valley Trail Relocation

Irrevocable multi-use, multi-season public recreational trail easement, 10' wide. To include:

- fixed entrance and egress points
- reroute will remain on the Largent's property, and be relocated to the southern perimeter (red line on attached photo)
- the recreational trail easement will run with the land
- the trail will be open 24/7
- landowner is responsible for construction costs, excluding hand finishing
- the trail will be approximately 6,000' in length
- relocation & construction will be completed by 31 October 2025

Sustainable Design Concepts

- Contour Layout
 - * conforming to a Sidehill location to the terrain and contours (aka contour alignment)
- Grade control
 - * trail alignment is less than 50% of the sideslope grade (aka half rule)
 - * overall grade does not exceed 10%
- Integrated Water Control
 - * create an outslope to promote sheet flow... ~3%
 - * Rolling Grade Dips at frequent intervals
 - * dip in & out of drainages to shed water and prevent stream capture
- Durable Surface
 - * naturally surfaced, full bench construction
