It is considered that funds contributed by the Territory under the Cooper ative Agreement are applicable to the cost of maintaining the entire Feeder and Local Road system, amounting to some 2570 miles as of this date.



All proposed construction projects for Federal-aid highway funds are submitted to the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for their concurrence and approval, and, unfortunately, this section of road was not considered at the recent board meeting that established the fiscal year 1960 construction program.

John Le Fevre of Cordova, and the Territorial Director of Highways is Mr. Lee Hubbard of 1228 East 7th Street, Anchorage. A copy of your letter is being sent to the Territorial Department for their consideration, both as regards future Federal-aid programs and for possible programming from Territorial mondes.
