By virtue of the authority vested in the President and pursuant to Executive Order No. 9337 of April 24, 1943, it is ordered as follows:

Subject to valid existing rights, the following-described public land in Alaska is hereby withdrawn from all forms of appropriation under the public land laws, including the mining laws, but not the mineral-leasing laws, and reserved for the use of the Alaska Road Commission as an administrative site:

The area described contains 15.62 acres.

Executive Order No. 8979 of December 16, 1941, establishing the Kenai National Moose Range, is hereby revoked so far as it affects the above-described land.

Notice is hereby given that for a period of 30 days from the date of publication of this notice, persons having cause to object to the terms of Public Land Order No. of withdrawing lot 2, sec. 32, T. 5 N., R. 10 W., S. M., Alaska, for the use of the Alaska Road Commission as an administrative site, may present their objections to the Secretary of the Interior. Such objections should be in writing, should be addressed to the Secretary of the Interior, and should be filed in duplicate in the Department of the Interior, Washington 25, D. C.

In case any objection is filed and the nature of the opposition is such as to warrant it, a public hearing will be held at a convenient time and place, which will be announced, where opponents to the order may state their views and where the proponents of the order can explain its purpose, intent and extent. Whether or not a hearing is held, notice of the determination by the Secretary as to whether the order should be rescinded, modified, or let stand will be given to all interested parties and the general public.

Withdrawing Public Land for the Use of the Alaska Road Commission as an Administrative Site, Alaska.

Pertinent information:

The 15.62-acre tract of public land is needed by the Alaska Road Commission for use as a supply base near the junction of the main road between Russian River and Homer with the Kenai Branch, in connection with the survey and future construction and maintenance of the Branch road. It is within the Kenai National Moose Range, established by Executive Order No. 8979 of December 16, 1941. It is, however, within that portion of the reserve which, under the first proviso to the Executive Order, remains under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management and subject to disposition under the public land laws applicable to Alaska. The Fish and Wildlife Service has reported that it has no objection to the proposed use.

The tract is within the boundaries of Kenai National Moose Range, established by Executive Order No. 8979 of December 16, 1941. It is, however, within the portion of the reserve which under the terms of the first proviso of the Executive Order remains under the primary jurisdiction of this bureau and subject to disposition under the public land laws applicable to Alaska. The Fish and Wildlife Service has reported that it has no objection to the proposed use.

The land is needed for a supply base near the junction of the road between Russian River and Homer with the Kenai Branch, in connection with the survey and future construction and maintenance of the Kenai road. The Regional Cadastral Engineer has reported that the tract will be a site for permanent camp buildings, and is necessary for the project; that it is not claimed by or occupied by the improvements of any individual or other agency; that no native rights are involved. Although a survey has been made, a plat has not yet been filed, and there are no claims of record.

An advance hearing in accordance with paragraph 2 of Order No. 2232 is not deemed necessary since (1) the proposed use of this small tract in connection with the construction of the road will be in the public interest and (2) there were no settlers in the vicinity when the survey was completed and there has been no indication of interest by settlers since that time. A draft of notice for filing objections is attached, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Order No. 2232.
