Trespass on public lands and on certain withdrawn or SUBJECT: reserved lands (Departmental Order No. 2519).

The following is quoted from Departmental Order No. 2519, dated May 19, 1949. The instructions in this order will be strictly complied with.

"Sec. 1. Reports of trespass to be made by departmental employees. All bureaus and offices of the Department of the Interior having field representatives are hereby directed to instruct such representatives to report promptly to the appropriate regional administrator, Bureau of Land Management, all cases coming to their notice of unauthorized occupation, use or trespass on the public lands, including timber depredations, trespass involving the removal of coal or other mineral deposits, and unauthorized use for railways, tramways, pipe lines, ditches, canals, reservoirs, telephone or telegraph systems, power plants or bill boards; also to report any unauthorized occupation or use of withdrawn or reserved lands under the jurisdiction of such bureaus or agencies, where authority for occupation or use could be granted through the Eureau of Land Management on proper application under the public land laws. The field representatives will regard all occupation or use as unauthorized, for the purpose of reporting it, unless it is expressly authorized by law or is based on authority which has been actually granted by this Department.
