Dear sir:

The following is a report of my activities as special officer for the suppression of the liquor traffic among natives in the Fourth Division, during the month of August 1928.

1 August:- At Hely Cross, Masks, working on monthly reports, and availing transportation to Russian Missian and the Kuskokwim River.

2- 4 August: - At Hely Cross, making local investigations and

awaiting transportation to Ruskervin River.

5 August: - Loft Hely Cross, Alaska, at midnight for Russion

Mission, via Steamer Jacobs.

6 August: - Arrived at Russion Mission at 6:00 a.m. and left Steamer Jacobs, ametiting mail boat for Kuskokwim River. Distance traveled by steamer 65 miles.

7 August: - Left Russion Mission, at 8:00 a.m. via Chas. Jacobson's gas boat for the Euckohwim River, Warren S. Harding, Pederal Prohibition Agent, with me. Arrived at High Portage at

4:00 mines distance traveled by gas boat 45 miles.

8 August: Latt High Portage at 9:50 a.m. via gas boat, in company with W. S. Harding, Pederal Prohibition Agent, who is accompanying me on trip of investigation on the Kuskokwim River, arrived at Kuckelwim Portage at 8:30 p.m., distance traveled by

gas beat 70 miles.

9 August:- Left Englowin Portage at 10:00 a.m., arrived on Kuskokvin River at 11:30 a.m.; where I had a gas beat in waiting for trip up the Kuskokwis River, leaving in around 12 O'Clock, first stop was made at Kushegometer where we searched for liquor and stills, with so results, afterwhich we continued up stream searching all of the metive's campa as we came to them, with no results, arrived at Chegometa at 5:00 p.m. made search of village and stopped for the might, as results. Distance traveled during

the day by gas book 31 alles. August 10:- Left Chegomite At 7:00 a.m., in company with W. S. Harding, Federal Prohibition Agent, via gas beet, searching all comps as we went up stream, with no results, arrived at laint at 12:30 pens, where we put in the afternoon and aight, with me

results, distance traveled 80 miles.

11 August: - Left Aniak at 9:00 a.m. via gas beet, together with Agent Harding, scarching all camps as we journeyed up stream, with no results. (at this point we was told that Wa. Rabidou, a native, was going ahead with a factor beat, notifying the camps that we were enroute) arrived at Mapanate at \$130 p.m., distance traveled by gas best 30 miles.
