Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant enclosing and explanatory of certain vouchers covering expenditures for work and material in construction of shelter cabihs on Dahl-Immachuck trail, payment on such vouchers having been previously refused by this effice because of insufficient detail contained therein.

I note that your letter states you talked of the construction of these cabins with Governor Strong, when in Seattle, but the Governor has no recollection of such talk though admits it may have been mentioned in a general conversation. However, with one or two exceptions, these vouchers make no mention of where or for what purpose the expenditure was incurred and, had the Governor a perfect recollection of the conversation, the vouchers could not have been connected up with such expenditure. By taking copies of your explanatory letter and attaching them to the original of each voucher, with reference on the face of the veucher to the matter attached, we have been enabled to pass the vouchers for payment.

These vouchers would have been passed for payment when originally presented if made out in the proper manner. After heading and deting, on the top line of the tody of the voucher should be worded as follows: "FOR SERVICES REMDERED (OR MATERIAL FURNISHED) in construction of shelter cabins on Dagl-Immachack trails; this wording to be followed by the detail. If for services, the massecter of such should be given, the member of days, dates and escent per day. If for material, the character of such should be given, the date

furnished, quanities furnished and prices in detail. After this detail, where the work is in such remote places as to make contracting impracticable, necessitating purchase of materials in open market and construction work by days labor, (as in the case under discussion,) certificate to this effect should follow, signed by the Road Commissioner and his assistants. In the case of work done by contract, a copy of such instrument, properly drawn and attached to the voucher, furnished to desired detail.

Recollections of a conversation make a very poor basis for approval of expenditures of money. Every voucher submitted to this office should contain complete detail in itself so that any one examing, now or ten years from now, will know all about the transaction covered. Payment will be refused on vouchers not in compliance with these instructions which I will ask be communicated to your successor in office.

Previous to his approval for payment, Governor Strong has referred to this office, voucher for \$500.00 to J.O.Busard & Oscar Brink for road rand work done in the vicinity of Shoups Bay, and forwarded in your letter of Nov. 10th. This voucher together with its various matters found attached is herewith returned for reasons found following.

- 1. Your signature certifying to correctnes of the amount is missing From both original and duplicate voucher.
- 2. On the next to last page of the contract attached to the voucher the following wording is found:

******; all payments to be made in duplicate vouchers properly signed by the persons performing the labor, forwarded by the party of the first part to the Governor of Alaska, ******

As the Territory has nothing to do with the payment to the laborers hired by the contractors, but pays these latter only and to whom the vouchers run, this wording in the contract is not in keeping with our atheds of settlement at all, and the voucher cannot be paid so long as the wording appears in the contract. It must be either stricken out, or the words undeerscored in the above be made to road "the parties of the second part".

3. Approval and Acceptance of the Assistant Road Commissioners should appear on the contract instead of which we find their names on the vouchers.

When corrections in voucher and contract are made in accordance with the above, the vouchers will be passed for payment. If Assistant Road Convissioners, McDonald & Currie, can be conveniently reached, please have them date and sign a certificate of inspection, approval and acceptance of the work performed under the contract, such certificate to be placed at the end of the contract. If they cannot be easily reached, however, an exception will be made in this instance and the voucher paid without such certificate, inasmach as their signatures have been placed upon the voucher.

It is presumed that the above voucher is the one referred to in your letter so this office of Nov. 10th, in which you state that vouchers for road work are being mailed to the Governor and that the parties wish the check cent to them in care of the Warst Bank of Valdes. No seems are mentioned in your letter and if these are the parties meant please so advise when corrected matters are returned.






