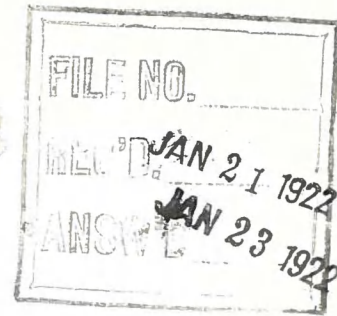

Dear Mr. Smith:-

Yours of December 3rd was received a short time ago and I have been trying to get a statement of the Shelter Cabins account from Messers Ross and Sheldon. Mr. Ross has finally turned over to me a copy of report which he claims was forwarded to Mr. Sommers and this report shows a balance of \$119.27 in the Shelter Cabins account, which agrees with our books, and as Mr. Sheldon is out of office this amount should be covered into the Treasury.

Regarding the old road appropriation, which you say ^{there} is a balance of \$28.00; two checks out standing No. 699 of April 9, 1919 in favor of Carl Jacket, for services \$16.00 and No. 1181 of Nov. 11, 1920 in favor of Ed. Brown, board, \$12.00. Our last report to you will show that the last item of \$12.00 has been paid. I took up the other item of \$16.00 with Mr. Ross who claims that this was issued for services rendered either at Ruby or Iditarod and that they had written Mr. Jackett to turn this draft in, but to date no word had been received from him, so the chances are that it has been either lost or destroyed and probably will never be presented for payment.

Dear Mr. Hess:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 7th inst., and very much appreciate the trouble taken in trying to get us straightened on old Shelter Cabin and Road matters.

As you say, the \$119.27 remaining in the old Shelter Cabin account should now be covered back in the Treasury. It belongs to an expired appropriation and there is no one now with authority to order it expended. I should think this could be done without awaiting return of Mr. Hutchinson. If you agree with me, I will be glad if you will have it transferred to my Treasurer's account. As soon as I receive word that this has been done, I will send in receipt, in Mr. Hutchinson's name, showing such amount as recovered into the Treasury.

The small amount remaining in the Old Road Account will probably be best left there for a time, against possible presentation of the warrant mentioned in your letter. Later on it too can be recovered into the Treasury if the warrant fails to turn up.
