Subject: Juneau-Eagle River Road.


Gentlemen:

1. It is highly desirable in the interest of economy to continue work on the Juneau-Eagle River road as long as weather conditions are favorable. We have a very efficient working crew, good camp established, etc., and it is proposed that your Board allot \$5,000 from Territorial funds, to become immediately available, in order that the work may continue.

2. In case the allotment is made I propose to do all in my power to have the \$5,000 credited to any future cooperative agreement on this project with the Department of Agriculture and Alaska Road Commission.

3. For cooperative purposes the Alaska Road Commission will handle the work, provide superintendence, furnish tools, etc., as we have in the past.



Subject: Expenditures in Nome District.

1. We have received the following telegram from our Acting Superintendent at Nome:

"Cartzenberger & Wilson have twenty seven hundred and seventy poles 10 feet long one hundred and sixty stringers 20 feet long, price on poles forty seven cents stringers ninety four cents delivered along route of road."

2. I would respectfully recommend that we be authorized to purchase these poles and stringers (\$517.94) with Territorial funds, making payment through the Disbursing Officer, Alaska Road Commission. We will then allow credit for this amount on any cooperative projects entered into for the Nome District.

Subject: Shelter Cabin Fund.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with instructions received from the Governor of Alaska, we have made the following obligations from the Shelter Cabin Fund:

Iditarod Trail .....	\$1,500
Second Division Trails .....	1,500

As bills for the shelter cabins and dog barns constructed have now been received, it is requested that deposit of \$3,000 be made to our credit with the Treasurer of the United States to cover.

Of the \$2,000 remaining available for the current year, it is recommended that we be authorized to obligate \$1,000 for a shelter cabin on the Nizina-Chisana Trail and that \$1,000 be reserved for the northern half of the Fourth Division, pending receipt of reports upon investigations in that area.

None of the shelter cabin money has been expended in the Third Division. The above cabin is recommended by Mr. Gus. Johnson, Divisional Commissioner for the Third Division and is, in our opinion, the most worthy project in the Third Division and possibly the most pressing project in the Territory at this time.

Gentlemen:

This office has no record of the co-operative agreements entered into between your Commission and the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners nor does there seem to be any record in the office of the Secretary of the Territorial Board, its copies of the agreements apparently having never been delivered after forwarding to Washington for signature of the Secretary of Agriculture.

For our information and records, will you kindly furnish us with abstracts of the different agreements, the same to show date of execution by the Territorial Board, amounts to be contributed by the different participators therein, the projects covered by the agreements, and date of execution by your Commission and the Secretary of Agriculture? While it is believed that no formal agreements were entered into for projects in the Second and Fourth Road Districts, we should like also to be informed regarding the informal agreements, that is, the amount to be contributed by the Territorial Board and the offsetting amount to be expended by your Commission, this information not detailed as regarding any special project, but naming those contemplated under the co-operative informal agreements and giving total amounts to be contributed by the participants in each road district.

The information requested above will be much appreciated.




