Subject: Cooperation

1. The Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska hereby agrees to assume and carry out the construction and maintenance of the roads and trails in the Territory of Alaska during the calendar year 1919, in accordance with the schedule of expenditure hereafter set forth:

(a) Third Division: Heward-Kenai Road- \$1,000 allotment by the Alaska Road Commission and \$15,000 allotment by the Territory. In the case of this project, this agreement is to be replaced by the formal cooperative agreement with the Department of Agriculture, which carries an allotment of \$10,000 by that Department, as soon as the agreement is received.

(b) In consideration of your allotment of \$30,000 to apply upon the hereinafter mentioned Territorial cooperative projects, we have allotted \$5,000 for the Second Division and will allot \$15,000 additional as soon as we receive notice of our expected \$300,000 appropriation. The projects upon which the \$30,000 territorial allotment will be applied are as follows:

Candle Creek road	\$10,000
Deering Road	2,000
Casa de Pago	5,000
Fort Davis-Cape Nome	19,000
Solomon-East Fork	1,500
Nome-Ft. Davis road	1,400
Council-Corduroy road	1,000

Winter trails	5,000

(c) In addition to the above, we will allot funds to bring our total to \$20,000 for the following:

Dime Creek road	8,500
Purchase of 2 auto trucks & supplies	8,000

(d) While the total of this list of projects exceeds the amount of the allotments, we will apply the funds to such projects as can be handled to the best advantage.

(e) We are prepared to allot \$10,500 additional to the Second Division, provided the Territory will add \$17,500 to their allotment for the projects above mentioned and provided the work is done under our direction. All allotments in the second division are contingent upon our expected Congressional appropriation of \$300,000. If this appropriation is reduced we will be compelled to reduce our allotment in the same proportion.

(f) Fourth Division: In consideration of your allotment of \$15,000 to apply on the hereinafter mentioned projects, we have allotted \$5,000, and will allot \$10,000 additional, for the Fourth Division. The projects upon which the allotments will be applied are as follows:

(g) As in the case of the Second Division, the total of the above projects exceeds the allotments and we will apply the funds to such projects as can be handled to the best advantage. We are prepared to allot \$27,500 additional to the Fourth Division allotment provided the Territory will add \$32,500 to their allotment for the above mentioned projects, and provided the Tacotna-Ophir project, \$20,000, is added to the above list, and of course, with the further provision that the work is done under our supervision. All allotments by this Commission for the Fourth Division, in excess of the \$5,000 now available, are also contingent upon our receipt of the \$300,000 appropriation. If this appropriation is reduced it will be necessary to reduce our allotment in the same proportion.

(h) First Division: In consideration of your allotment of \$2,000 for the Basin Road out of Juneau, we have allotted \$1,000.

2. Your acceptance of the above allotment schedule will be considered as effecting the required cooperative agreement, as

contemplated by Section 2 of the Territorial Road Act, and the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska considers itself bound to furnish the funds above mentioned, but subject to the provisions contingent upon our \$300,000 appropriation. The work is now under way on several of these projects and the others will be undertaken as soon as the necessary arrangements can be made.

3. All cost of general supervision, accounting, office maintenance and expense, will be borne by this office. The proportionate share of the total expense to be borne by the Territorial Treasury, as indicated in this schedule, is to be deposited in the Treasury of the U.S., subject to the official check of the Disbursing Officer of the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska, deposits to be made at such times and in amounts necessary to carry on the work. A detailed account of the expenditure of such Territorial funds will be furnished the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners at the close of each calendar year.

Dear Sir:

This letter is to inform you that this office has recently received from the United States Treasury, a warrant in the sum of \$25,456.77, the said warrant being in settlement of the Territory's statutory percentage of receipts of the National Forests in Alaska for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1919.

The amount received was covered into the Forest Reserve Fund of the Territory, and from which, under advice from the Attorney General for the Territory, it has been given the following distribution:


Twenty-five per cent. (25%) of the total amount, or \$6,364.17, has been transferred to the Public School Current Fund, for the maintenance of a public school system, in accordance with provisions of Sec. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$, Chap. 74, Session Laws of 1915;

Seventy-five per cent. (75%) of the total amount, or \$19,092.60, has been transferred to the General Fund, for the building, repairing and maintaining of trails, roads and bridges, in accordance with provision of Sec. 6, Chap. 27, Session Laws of 1915, being made supplemental to appropriations for road, bridge and trail purposes for the period ending March 31, 1921, and divided in equal sums of \$4,773.15 to each of the four road districts of the Territory, to be expended under the direction of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, the equal division between the four road districts being in accordance with provisions of Sec. 7, Chap. 27, Session Laws of 1915.



In the case of this project, this agreement is to be replaced by the formal cooperative agreement with the Department of Agriculture, which carries an allotment of \$10,000 by that Department, as soon as the agreement is received.

(b) In consideration of your allotment of \$30,000 to apply upon the hereinafter mentioned Territorial cooperative projects, we have allotted \$5,000 for the Second Division and will allot \$15,000 additional as soon as we receive notice of our expected \$300,000 appropriation. The projects upon which the \$30,000 territorial allotment will be applied are as follows:

(c) In addition to the above, we will allot funds to bring our total to \$20,000 for the following:

(d) While the total of this list of projects exceeds the amount of the allotments, we will apply the funds to such projects as can be handled to the best advantage.

(e) We are prepared to allot \$10,500 additional to the Second Division, provided the Territory will add \$17,500 to their allotment for the projects above mentioned and provided the work is done under our direction. All allotments in the second division are contingent upon our expected Congressional appropriation of \$300,000. If this appropriation is reduced we will be compelled to reduce our allotment in the same proportion.

(f) Fourth Division: In consideration of your allotment of \$15,000 to apply on the hereinafter mentioned projects, we have allotted \$5,000, and will allot \$10,000 additional, for the Fourth Division. The projects upon which the allotments will be applied are as follows:

(g) As in the case of the Second Division, the total of the above projects exceeds the allotments and we will apply the funds to such projects as can be handled to the best advantage. We are prepared to allot \$27,500 additional to the Fourth Division allotment provided the Territory will add \$32,500 to their allotment for the above mentioned projects, and provided the Tacotna-Ophir project, \$20,000, is added to the above list, and of course, with the further provision that the work is done under our supervision. All allotments by this Commission for the Fourth Division, in excess of the \$5,000 now available, are also contingent upon our receipt of the \$300,000 appropriation. If this appropriation is reduced it will be necessary to reduce our allotment in the same proportion.

(h) First Division: In consideration of your allotment of \$2,000 for the Basin Road out of Juneau, we have allotted \$1,000.

2. Your acceptance of the above allotment schedule will be considered as effecting the required cooperative agreement, as

contemplated by Section 2 of the Territorial Road Act, and the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska considers itself bound to furnish the funds above mentioned, but subject to the provisions contingent upon our \$300,000 appropriation. The work is now under way on several of these projects and the others will be undertaken as soon as the necessary arrangements can be made.

3. All cost of general supervision, accounting, office maintenance and expense, will be borne by this office. The proportionate share of the total expense to be borne by the Territorial Treasury, as indicated in this schedule, is to be deposited in the Treasury of the U.S., subject to the official check of the Disbursing Officer of the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska, deposits to be made at such times and in amounts necessary to carry on the work. A detailed account of the expenditure of such Territorial funds will be furnished the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners at the close of each calendar year.
