Memorandum:

Subject- Cooperative roads.

Record of conference of-
Captain John C. Getwals, Corps of Engineers, President, Alaska Road Commission,
Major William H. Waugh, Engineers, U.S. Army, Alaska Road Commission,
Mr. Robert Semmers, Surveyer General, Territory of Alaska, Secretary of Territorial Road Commission,
Mr. Walstein G. Smith, Treasurer, Territory of Alaska, Member of Territorial Road Commission,
Mr. C. H. Purcell, District Engineer, District No. 1, Bureau of Public Roads,
Mr. C. H. Flery, Superintendent of Alaskan Forests, Bureau of Forestry,

the above constituting representations of the Alaska Road Commission, War Department, the Territory of Alaska and the Department of Agriculture, entered into the consideration of the status of the Cooperative Roads being constructed in Southeastern Alaska by the Department of Agriculture, with funds provided by the Alaska Road Commission, the Territory of Alaska and the Department of Agriculture.

The construction upon these roads had been heretofore supervised by Major Waugh, representing the Alaska Road Commission and the Department of Agriculture, with disbursements made from War Department funds and Territorial funds by the Disbursing Officer, Alaska Road Commission, and from the Department of Agriculture funds disbursed by the Fiscal Agent, Department of Agriculture.

The Solicitor, Department of Agriculture, having decided that all funds spent upon these agreements must be disbursed by the Fiscal Agents attached to the Department of Agriculture, the following changes in the status of the cooperative agreements was agreed to be necessary.

First, All disbursements by the Alaska Road Commission upon the following roads should cease at once and a balance struck as of July 1, 1920:

Portage Road
Ketchikan-Wards Cove
Petersburg-Scow Bay
Juneau-Eagle River
Seward-Kenai Lake

The other cooperative roads under construction received no funds disbursed by the Alaska Road Commission.

Second, The balance of Territorial funds received by the Alaska Road Commission and not disbursed up to July 1st upon these roads is then to be returned as a credit to the Territory of Alaska and allotted by the Alaska Road Commission to other projects under construction with funds from the Alaska Road Commission and the Territory of Alaska, only.

Third, The balance of Territorial funds received by the Alaska Road Commission and not disbursed up to July 1st upon these roads, when returned to the Territory of Alaska to be deposited with the Fiscal Agent attached to the Department of Agriculture for disbursement upon the aforementioned cooperative roads.

Fourth, The Alaska Road Commission funds allotted to these cooperative roads to be withdrawn and used in the reconstruction of the Haines-Pleasant Camp Road.
