A.R.C. CRDER NO. 40

SUBJECT: Numbering System for Alaska Roads

A.R.C. Order No. 34, dated September 15, 1950 is hereby revoked in its entirety, and is superseded by the provisions of this order.

1. Purpose

A new numbering system is hereby prescribed to replace the old system of "Route Numbers" for roads in Alaska. The new system is intended to accomplish the following purposes:

- a. To reduce the number of route designations for roads by grouping like roads.
- b. To provide a descriptive number for use in the field.
- c. To give an accounting number for use in the office, indicating the District, location, and type of road.

2. Decimal System

Each road will be assigned a number consisting of three digits to the left of a decimal point, and local roads will also have one or more digits to the right of the decimal point.

- a. The first digit, beginning at the left, indicates the general system of roads of which the particular road is a part. If this digit is zero, it indicates that the road is an isolated one and not a part of any one of the primary systems.
- b. The second digit indicates the District in which the road is located.
- c. The third digit, when it is a zero, indicates that the road referred to is the primary highway of the system as designated by the first digit. A numeral normally indicates that the road is a feeder road from the primary highway, but is also used to indicate that all or part of the primary highway is built to the feeder road standard.
- d. The first figure to the right of the decimal point is used to designate a local road system or an individual road. If the number of local roads or local systems, branching off a given main road or feeder, exceeds 9 the numbering continues through 10, 11, etc. Normally, only one number to the right of the decimal point will be sufficient for cost accounting and for assignment of work orders. However, accurate

information on mileage of all roads, whether systems or individual roads, is required semi-annually. Local names should continue to be assigned to roads for ready identification in the field. If the Districts so desire they may numerically identify individual local roads by adding a second decimal and further numbers.

3. Systems of Roads

The following primary systems of roads have been designated:

Route 1 - Richardson Highway and branches

Route 2 - Alaska Highway and branches

Route 3 - Glenn Highway (including Tok Cutoff), its extension to Fr.gle and branches

Route 4 - Seward - Anchorage Highway and branches

Route 5 - Sterling Highway and branches

Route 6 - Steese Highway and branches

Route 7 - Elliott Highway, its extension to Manley Hot Springs, and branches

Route 8 - Paxson-Centwell-McKinley Perk Road, its extension to Kantishne, and branches

Route 9 - Juneau, Tce Harbor, Haines, Haines Junction, and branches

4. Numerical Designation of Districts

The following numerical designations of Districts are to be used in the numbering system:

Anchorage District - No. 1

Valdez District - No. 2

Fairbanks District - No. 3

Nome District - No. 4

Haines Sub-district- No. 5

5. Explanation

Attached hereto is a list intended to reflect all roads under A.R.C. jurisdiction. This gives old route numbers and gives mileage as accurately as it can be determined from information available to this office.

Within the coming season each District should check all mileages within their jurisdiction and report any discrepancies. This report should cover any mileage definitely abandoned and should correct mileage affected by realignment. It is believed that a study of the above, together with the attached list, will readily show the method used and the simplicity of the system. It will be noted that the Sterling Highway itself is numbered 511 in order that its standard of construction may be identified by the third numeral as being that of feeder standard. In the same way the Steese Highway is partly 630 and partly 631. Care should be taken to avoid duplication of mileage where two roads may be felt to coincide. For example the Steese Highway should be measured from the city limits but the Steese Highway to University road is now considered a branch of the Steese and should be measured from the junction of the two. It will be noted that some roads numbered as feeders, because of their geographical position, are listed under the heading Through Roads because of their construction standard. The Matanuska - Wasilla Junction road should be measured from the junction with the Palmer - Matanuska road just north of Matanuska to the junction with the Finger Lake - Wasilla road east of Wasilla.

There is also attached a reconciliation list which is designed to inform the field offices as to how certain mileages were adjusted or how certain roads were reclassified. Further reconciliation will be necessary at the end of this season, when all Districts have reported on their mileage check. In the meantime new construction will be added to our records from the monthly reports submitted by the Districts and it is requested that utmost care be given this feature of the reports.

Changes in names or courses of routes are listed below. These changes have been made to clarify the existing system and eliminate the dividing of certain roads into mumerous routes. The Fillingham - Sood River network, Soute 013, has been corrected to reflect the true mileage of the roads maintained during the past seasons. The total mileage also includes 1.1 miles taken over for maintenance during the past season.

The Lake Otis Road, Route 310.1, has incorporated the Aircort Heights Road and the Wells Road, completing the loop from Glenn Highway to the Potter Road. That portion of Lake Otis Road lying in an east—west direction and connecting with Fireweed Lane, has been incorporated in the total mileage of Fireweed Lane.

The road from Fishbook Junction to Willow has been incorporated into one route, being Route 314.2.1, comprising 44.6 miles. Roads leading to this system have been left unchanged.

The mileage record card for the Naknek Beach to Airport Road is revised to reveal "as constructed" mileage of 13.3 miles and the title to read as above rather than Naknek Beach to Naknek.

The following road has been deleted from our records, as it falls within the newly incorporated City of Palmer:

Community Center Road - Route 312.1, containing 1.2 miles

Subject: Numbering System for Alaska Roads

Sheets 4 to 12 inclusive, of ARC Order No. 40 dated February 6, 1951, are revoked in their entirety and the attached sheets are to be substituted therefor.

The revised sheets have been compiled from data received from the various districts and reflect the district changes and recommendations as well as such changes as deemed advisable by Headquarters.

As changes have occurred either in route numbers or mileage in all districts, it is requested that the revised sheets be reviewed carefully by District Personnel and any errors or omissions reported to Headquarters on a marked copy of the revised sheets, together with comments, not later than October 15, 1952. Negative reports are requested if no corrections are required.

Further, it is desired that revised mileages reflecting the changes due to construction during the current season together with names of new roads be submitted to Headquarters by December 1, 1952. This report may also be made on a marked copy of the revised sheets.

All route numbers will continue to be assigned by Headquarters although District recommendations as to the grouping of new roads in the system or changes in the present grouping should be noted in the two reports requested above.

CONDITION OF ALASKA HIGHWAYS QUARTERLY REPORT

GENERAL

Construction and reconstruction activities are rapidly being brought to a close for the current season. In a short time operations will be entirely on a maintenance basis, aimed at keeping the main routes open for winter travel.

With the advent of cold weather travelers should take special precautions to insure that vehicles are in first-class condition and adequately protected for winter operation. Efficient heaters are necessary and chains should be carried at all times. Local inquiry should be made as to road conditions before starting on trips, as weather varies greatly during the winter months. With proper care of vehicles and adequate personal clothing and equipment, winter travel can be pleasant and safe.

For those planning to enter Alaska over highways in Canada, information as to Canadian highway conditions may be obtained from Mr. G. H. N. Monkman, Deputy Minister, Department of Public Works, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada.

ROAD CONDITIONS

Route No. 1, Richardson Highway: Open from Valdez, Mile O through Thompson Pass, Mile 26 to Big Timber Junction, Mile 130. Closed as of October 12 from Big Timber Junction through Isabel Pass-to junction with Alaska Highway at Big Delta, Mile 268. Traffic from Valdez to Fairbanks must now use the Glenn Highway (formerly Tok Cutoff) from Big Timber Junction to Tok Junction and thence over the Alaska Highway and Richardson Highway to Fairbanks.

Route No. 2. Alaska Highway: Open from Canadian boundary, Mile 1221 to Fairbanks. This route will be kept open during the winter months.

Route No. 3. Glenn Highway: Open from Anchorage to junction with the Alaska Highway at Mile 1318. The old narrow road is still in use in the vicinity of Mentasta Lake and on certain sections south of Tok Junction toward the Little Tok River. However, it is expected that these sections will be completed during the current season, thus providing a standard width reconstructed highway over the former Tok Cutoff.

Route No. 3. Taylor Highway (Tetlin to Eagle): This highway is still under construction. The road is now passable to the Canadian border

on the east and to the Forty Mile River on the north. Construction and maintenance will be halted late in October or early in November and the road permitted to close for the winter. Persons desiring to travel this route should inquire as to its condition at the local office of the Alaska Road Commission at Tok Junction.

Route No. 4. Seward to Anchorage Highway: Heavy reconstruction continues on this route from Seward to Mile 58. This section is passable though rough, and inquiry should be made as to times when travel may be restricted due to construction activity. This information may be obtained from the District Office of the Alaska Road Commission at Anchorage. From Mile 58 to Anchorage, Mile 128, the road is rapidly being completed and is now suitable for travel without construction delays or hazards.

Route No. 5. Sterling Highway: Reconstruction has been discontinued for this season, and all work is on a maintenance basis. This route is open for its entire length to Homor on the southern end and will be maintained for winter travel.

Route No. 6. Steese Highway: This highway is now closed for the winter.

Route No. 7. Elliott Highway: This highway is now closed for the winter.

Route No. 8, McKinley Park Roads: The roads in McKinley Park are closed for the winter.

Route No. 9. Haines Highway: Open from Haines to the junction with the Alaska Highway, Mile 160 (Alaska Highway Mile 1016). It is anticipated that this route will be closed from the Canadian border, Mile 41 to the junction with the Alaska Highway late in October or early in November. Information may be obtained from the Alaska Road Commission office at Haines.

CONDITIONS OF ALASKAN HIGHWAYS QUARTERLY REPORT

GENERAL

Construction and reconstruction activities are rapidly drawing to a close for the current season, and, in a short time, operations will be entirely on a maintenance basis aimed at keeping the main routes open for winter travel.

With the advent of the winter season, travelers should take special precautions to insure that vehicles are in good operating condition and adequately protected for winter driving. Chains should be carried at all times and an efficient heater is a necessity. Recently developed special cold weather lubricants are now available and should be used as required. Local inquiry should be made at each stop as to conditions ahead, as weather and roads can vary greatly during the winter months.

For those planning to enter Alaska over highways in Canada, information as to highway conditions from the United States border to Dawson Creek may be obtained from the Deputy Minister, Department of Highways, Edmonton, Alberta; and from the Commander, Northwest Highway System, Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, for the section between Dawson Creek and the Alaskan border. It is planned to include information about roads in Canada in future reports when present plans for such exchange of road information have been completed.

ROAD CONDITIONS

Route No. 1, Richardson Highway

Open from Valdez, Mile 0, to Big Timber Junction, Mile 130, and from Big Delta Junction, Mile 268, to Fairbanks, Mile 365. Closed for the winter approximately October 18, between Big Timber Junction and Big Delta Junction, with all Fairbanks traffic from Valdez and Anchorage routed over the Glenn Highway to Tok Junction, the Alaska Highway to Big Delta and thence to Fairbanks. This route is in good condition, being paved at present from Valdez to Mile 24, from Mile 82 to Mile 130, and from Big Delta to Fairbanks. Mile 268 to Mile 365.

Route No. 2, Alaska Highway

Open from the Canadian boundary, Mile 1221, to Big Delta, Mile 1428. This route is in good condition and is paved from Tok Junction, Mile 1316, to Big Delta, Mile 1428.

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Route No. 3, Glenn Highway

Open from Anchorage to junction with Alaska Highway at Tok. In good condition and paved from Anchorage to Big Timber Junction, Mile 203.

Taylor Highway (Tetlin Junction to Eagle & Dawson)

This highway will close for the winter very shortly as maintenance for the season has now been discontinued. Persons desiring to travel this road should first inquire as to its condition at the Tok Junction office of the Alaska Road Commission.

Route No. 4. Seward to Anchorage Highway

This highway is in good condition. The section from Seward to Mile 58 has been widened and improved preparatory to paving and the remaining 70 miles of the route, from Mile 58 to Anchorage, is paved.

Route No. 5, Sterling Highway

This route is in good condition for its entire length to Homer including branches to Kenai, Kasilof and Ninilchik, and will be maintained for winter travel.

Route No. 6, Steese Highway

Maintenance has now been discontinued for the winter on this route and officially it is closed beyond Chatanika, Mile 31, for the winter.

Route No. 7, Elliott Highway

Maintenance has now been discontinued beyond Olnes, Mile 6, and the road closed from Olnes to Livengood for the winter.

Route No. S. McKinley Park Roads

The roads in McKinley Park are closed for the winter.

Route No. 9, Haines Highway

Open from Haines to the junction with the Alaska Highway, Mile 160 (Alaska Highway, Mile 1016). It is anticipated that this route will be closed from the Canadian border, Mile 41, to the junction with the Alaska Highway late in October or early in November. Information should be obtained from the ARC offices at Juneau or Haines or from the Canadian maintenance personnel at Mile 1016 on the Alaska Highway before attempting to travel this route at this time of year.
