Dear Sir:

This is to advise you that some work has been authorized on the Eureka Field. This work is to be performed on a co-operative basis with interested parties operating in the vicinity of Eureka.

Mr. James McDonald has promised that he will furnish all fuel and a man to operate the grader while performing the work. The Alaska Road Commission will furnish the equipment and pay the operator's wages (yourself).

The work on the field to consist of necessary ditching to drain the field and if necessary, level the landing strip. Actual work on the field to consume no more than three days.

However, if it is necessary for you to make a special trip to Eureka to do this work, your time while making the trip and performing the work shall be charged against that job. Also the time for the tractor and grader shall be handled in the same manner.

However, be sure that McDonald furnishes all fuel, grease, etc. and a man to operate the grader, which will probably be nimself.
