As to sending you a dozer operator - if we can locate one whom we can depend on will send him down there; they are not plentiful, that is, good ones.

Will send you more gas and oil. Even though you do not use it this Fall, it is a good idea to have some on hand for a start next spring.

We do not have any extra rebuilt motors, cannot keep up with our local requirements. Would a new distributor, etc. be of any help? Six pints of oil is not prohibitive if the truck is doing any amount of work.

OKay to keep planks from the Baker Creek Mill.

We have some metal culverts. Advise by return mail as to the diameter and length needed and will see what we can do.
