Ford dump 588) 2 gauge assembly(electric fuel) tank unit Ford dump 589) 2 muffler and tail pipe 4 clutch and brake pedal pads

A C tractor 590 l adjusting rod-- governor to carbeurator 1 set (8) 18MM spark plugs 1 set (8) 13MM spark plugs

If you remember the timbers I showed you over by the warehouse, four 12x12-14' fir, think with those and a few others scattered around, also coming from Tanana, (which Black is bringing up tomorrow) I would have plenty to make another portable trap. I also have plenty of cable and enough old grader blades to shoe the skids. About all I would need would be the bolts and metal trap. Black will be in town for a week or two. If you have the parts you might send them with him.

I could build it this fall, or early next spring, and use it on the Eureka road. I am moving the other trap to the Sullivan pit in a few days.

Also need some large envelopes.
