

Gentlemen:

On August 11, 1981, I addressed a letter to you on behalf of my client, Mrs. Tryph Taylor, concerning the nature of the right of the right of the Department of Highways to open and extract gravel from what appears to be either Lots 2 & 3 or Lot 4 of Section 27, Township Seven South, Range Seven East, Fairbanks Meridian.

I received a telephone call later from someone from your department stating that the matter was being investigated and that we would receive a response in the near future. Several months have now elapsed and nothing further has been heard from the State. I had hoped that initially in investigating this matter it could be approached by both parties on an informal, amicable basis, rather than immediately adopting an adversary position.

I had hoped that you might furnish me with whatever documents, surveys, maps and so forth which you had, which indicated not only the basis of your right to dredge gravel in the area but also the area in which you are presumably dredging.

If we hear no further from you I will recommend to my client that she have the area surveyed and if indeed you are removing gravel from her property proceed with making the necessary claims for damages.

Material Source Renewals-Canyon Creek to Shaw Creek

The following material sources should be renewed for a period of at least 10 years for use by the DOT/PF in rebuilding, upgrading, and maintaining the public highways and roads in the vicinity:

62-4-103-2/62-4-**0**54-2 62-4-104-2 Gravel 62-4-105-2 Gravel 62-4-163-2 Gravel 62-4-160-2 Quarry 62-4-162-2 Gravel 62-3-122-2 Quarry

The gravel sources especially will be required for a paving project scheduled for construction this summer.

Quantities of material to be removed from the sources for this project are relatively small (less than 20,000 c.y.) and will not impose an erosion problem from the Tanana River. M.S. 62-4-104-2 is located on the flood plain and the adjacent highway is situated on schist bedrock at least 50 feet above the river.

M.S. 62-4-162-2 is separated from the roadway by the channel of Shaw Creek, the highway side of which is already protected from erosion by riprap. Utilization of this source will require construction of an access across a small channel that contains water during high stages of the Tanana but is ordinarily dry. A temporary bridge, may be required if the use of culverts is not adequate.

- -Excavated areas shall be left smoothed and/or graded to a neat condition, free of trenches, holes, ridges, or piles.
- -Cleared and grubbed material shall be disposed of, except where timber salvage is stipulated, by removal from the site to an approved area, by burning (subject to applicable regulations), or by burying.


- 1. This permit is issued subject to valid existing rights, such as may exist. Attention is directed toward the possibility of valid unpatented mining claims within the permit area.
- 2. No excavation of material will be done within the Nh NE Section 5 without prior authorization by amendment of this permit.
- 3. All trees within the permit area which measure six inches (6") or more D.B.H. (diameter, breast height) and which contain sixteen feet (16') or more in length below a four-inch (4") top trunk diameter shall be severed from the roots, limbed, topped, and neatly piled in an area accessible to the access road. Timber thus salvaged remains the property of the State.

#### -H.S.62-4-162-2

1. A strip of land at least 50 feet in width shall be left undisturbed between any waste area and the river channel as indicated on the Material Source map.

#### M.S.62-4-163-2

- 1. A strip of land at least 50 feet in width shall be left undisturbed between any waste area, excavation, or other disturbance and the Tanana River (Slough) as indicated on the Material Source map.
- 2. A strip of land at least 50 feet in width shall be left undisturbed between any waste area, excavation, or other disturbance and the northerly highway Right-of-Way limit.
- 3. Waste piles shall be no higher than 15 feet above surrounding grade.
