GUIDE TO DOT&PF REGIONAL ARCHIVES

What is the Archives?

It is the repository for DOT&PF's Northern Region collection of As-Advertised packets, As-Built Plans, aerial photos, various reports and topographical maps. This collection is maintained and continually updated.

An Admin Clerk is on hand to provide assistance to DOT&PF personnel and the public in finding information housed in this collection.

Most material may be checked out for 2 weeks but there are a few items that may not be checked out. These are labeled with "Do not remove from archives" label.

If you are leaving DOT&PF (either retiring or resigning) be sure to return any items you have checked out. If another person is continuing with your project and needs the material, have them come in and recheck them out.

There are two major areas where documents are stored.

A. Archives Room

The Archives Room in the Engineering Service Building. The following are kept in this area:

- 1. aerial photos dealing with highways and proposed highways;
- 2. Plan and Spec books for most of the jobs done since statehood and a few from before that;
- 3. 1/2 size As-Built plans for Highway jobs (aviation 1/2 size As-Builts are kept in Drafting);
- 4. microfilm and microfiche for some of these jobs and recent aviation jobs (in file cabinet in Contracts);
- 5. some full size as-built mylars for aviation and highway jobs;
- 6. miscellaneous reports, including design, location and environmental reports;
- 7. topographic maps for areas in the Northern Region;
- 8. updated Alaska Statutes; Alaska Administrative Code; Alaska Administrative Manual; DOT&PF Policy and Procedures Manual;

B. Cold Storage - "Mule Barn"

There are several sections to the cold storage area concerning Archives:

- 1. <u>Design Cold Storage</u>. Stored here are the following: Older As-Built plans; designer note books; misc project files which are purged occasionally; Aviation files purged by Aviation Design; spare binders. This area is maintained by the Archivist.
- 2. <u>Buildings Cold Storage</u>. This room has As- Built plans and other items related to Building projects.

3. <u>Construction Cold Storage</u>. This room and the halls have the files for projects that have been constructed. This area is maintained by Construction. 3 years after projects are finalized they are purged. When purged the As-Built plans are moved to the Design Cold Storage Room.

Putting Items Into Cold Storage:

Be sure to *purge* your files before putting them in Cold Storage. When putting your items in cold storage, or removing them, ask for assistance from the Admin Clerk.

C. Other areas where material may be found

- 1. Valdez and Nome have some plans, specs and aerial photos of their districts.
- 2. Aviation Design has aerial photos of villages where the Northern Region maintains airports.
- 3. Materials Section maintains the collection of Geotech and Material Reports.

D. Index books

These are kept on top of the file cabinets by the door.

Main Index Book - listings for

- 1. Miscellaneous Reports
- 2. Flat File C design materials, large photos, etc
- 3. Aviation Plan & Spec Books, As-Built plans
- 4. Highway project listings by project name
- 5. Highway project listings by highway or area
- 6. Highway project listings by federal number
- 7. Highway project listings by AKSAS number

Topographic Map Index Book (includes sign out sheets too)

Cold Storage Building Index Book - listings for

- 1. Design Storage Room
- 2. Buildings Storage Room
- 3. Construction Storage Area

PROCEDURES FOR USING THE ARCHIVES

I. Aerial Photo Collection

Users may browse through the collection but must put the photo envelopes back in

the order you found them in the file drawer.

Photos may be checked out for two weeks. The whole envelope is to be checked out. Do not take a single photo. Department personnel may keep the photos for a longer period if prior arrangements are made. Do not take photos into the field. Instead have color xerox copies made for this purpose.

To check out aerial photos, get a check-out card out from the black "Photo Checkout" box. Fill in ALL the information requested on the card, except the return date, then place the card in the Photo Checkout box. A separate card should be filled out for each flight date.

When returning photos to the Archives, place them in the "Photo Return" box on top of the file cabinets. Do not refile them. If you want to get your sign-out card, from the sign-out box, to sign them in, feel free to do so, but then attach the sign-out card to the photo envelope with a paper clip. If not, the Admin Clerk will sign them in for you.

PHOTOS SHOULD NOT BE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE PERSON TO ANOTHER PERSON (this includes passing on to consultants or the A.G.'s Office) WITHOUT LETTING THE ADMIN CLERK KNOW.

Photos should not be marked on. Make copies for this purpose. Identifying remarks can be made on the envelopes. Do not use tape of any kind on the photos!

II. As-Advertised Plans & Spec Books & As-Built 1/2 Size Plans

As-Advertised Plan & Spec books are in different areas in the Archives rooms:

Aviation books are just to the left as you enter.

FIA books are in the 2nd room on the east wall by the window.

Nome and Valdez books are in the main room, on the north wall to the right of the window.

Some building jobs are on top of the row of file cabinets.

Highway books are along the east wall in the main room.

As-Built 1/2 Size Plans are in the flat files A, D and E.

<u>Flat file A</u> has the plans for the major highways. The drawers are labeled for easy browsing.

<u>Flat file D and E</u> have the plans for projects in the Fairbanks/North Pole/Chena Hot Springs Rd areas. It is best to look up what you want in the Index as these drawers are not labeled.

Checking out Plans & Spec Books or 1/2 size plans

Material from the plans or spec books can be easily copied in the Contracts area, so that it is not always necessary to check them out.

If you wish to check them out, sign them out in the green "Sign-out" book

on the file by the door. Make sure you fill in all the items on the list and sign your name legibly. Non Department users must also note their phone number and agency next to their name.

When returning the above items, place them in the document return box on top of the files. You can sign in the date you returned them. Do not refile the plans. The Admin Clerk will do this.

III. Other Reports, Publications & Miscellaneous Items

These are kept on the shelves on the west wall of the 2nd room. There is a listing of what is available in the Index book. These can be checked out like any spec book, in the same green check-out book. The return procedure is the same as for the spec books.

Alaska Statutes, Alaska Administrative Code; Alaska Administrative Manual, and DOT Policy and Procedures Manuals are **not** to be removed from the Archives. They are there for your reference. They can be found on the shelves over the file cabinets.

Flat File C contains larger photos and Design materials.

IV. Topographic Maps

These are found in flat file B. These can be checked out also. There is a red check-out/index book on top of the file by the door where plans must be signed out with a charge number.

V. Full size mylars

There are some full size mylar as-builts for Aviation and Highway in the hanging files in room 2. Also Aviation has EA and ALP mylars in this file. Contracts can make you copies of any of this material if you need them.

VI. Microfilm

We have many projects on microfilm. Some early projects and most recent projects. Those projects that have microfilms are noted with an "X" in the first column in front of the project name in the index book. These microfilms are kept in a file in Contracts. Ask the Admin Clerk for help in retrieving them and printing up copies, if necessary.

VII. Cold Storage

There is an index of what is stored in cold storage. The index is kept on top of the files by the door. Ask the Admin Clerk for assistance in retrieving items from cold storage.
