Clearing and Grubbing:  Sta. 351 to Sta. 586 - 95%. This is the only area where roadway clearing and grubbing is a separate pay item.  Borrow pits at Stations 80, 92, 176, 205, 262, 382, 443, 488, 594, 656, 697, 835 and Stations 362 and 366 on the relocation have been cleared.
Grading:  Necessary stripping on pits noted above has been completed.  Roadway excavation (Relocation only)
Sta. 351 to Sta. 401 - Fills are complete except for select. Cuts are mostly out but not finished.  Sta. 401 to Sta. 415 - Cuts are 90% out.  Sta. 415 to Sta. 420 - 70%. Cut is wet but material on Lt. is dry and fairly sandy. Contractor has borrowed
approx. 5000 c.y. here to make fill ahead.  Sta. 427 to Sta. 429 - 90%  Sta. 429 to Sta. 440 - 60%. Frozen area.  Sta. 440 to Sta. 475 - 1%. Stripping only.  Sta. 475 to Sta. 480 - 5%. Stripping has been moved hydraulically.  Sta. 488 to Sta. 501 - 25%
Sta. 501 to Sta. 515 - 14. Stripped and some fill made.  Sta. 515 to Sta. 521 - 30%  Sta. 521 to Sta. 536 - 14  Sta. 536 to Sta. 539 - 80%  Only miner activity on pipes to date.

#### 3. WORK IN PROGRESS:

Two D-8 dozers were idle at the contractor's shop Sta. 357.

A 10' pull grader was idle at Sta. 400.

An HD-19 tractor and carryall scraper combination was excavating in the cut at Sta. 406 and hauling to Sta. 403.

A #12 patrol grader was working at Sta. 410.

A carryall scraper was idle at Sta. 420.

A D-8 and a D-6 dozer were stripping left of Sta. 428.

A 3/4 yd. Koehring shovel was loading two DW-10 scraper units in the cut at Sta. 497 (frozen material). This wet muck was being deposited on the sides of a fill at Sta. 510. A D-7 dozer was on the dump. A 105 c.f.m. compressor was in use drilling the frozen cut for shooting.

A D-8 dozer was working in the channel of Johnson River diverting water from the proposed borrow pit.

Two D-8 dozers which had been clearing and stripping borrow pit sites were moved to Sta. 950 to clear off a camp site.

#### 4. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The contractor now has more equipment on the project than at any previous time and is bringing in more each day.

The hydraulic operation mentioned in this report and also in report #3 was small scale. Two pumps were used, a 2" for jetting and a 3" for "ground sluicing". Water was pumped from the Tanana River approximately 200' away. The contractor had piled some strippings in the center of the clearing while the ground was frozen and was unable to get near it later to haul it away. The hydraulic method was used only to remove this material. A large scale operation was considered for removing the frozen cuts in this vicinity. According to experts on hydraulic work it is now too late in the season as the melting action of the sun is a necessary factor.

Good progress has been made on pit clearing and stripping.

A small shovel is enroute to speed up placement of culverts.

The contractor is now using a 3/4 c.y. shovel in one of the frozen cuts. This unit cannot dig the frost and it is necessary to shoot immediately ahead of excavation as the shot material freezes solid again if left over night. It appears that heavier equipment, that can remove the frozen cuts with a minimum of shooting, will be required to complete this phase of the grading operation during this construction season.

#### 3. WORK IN PROGRESS:

3 men were using a derrick truck to install a 24" culvert at Sta. 63.

The 13 yd. dragline was piling up borrow material in the pit left of Sta. 75/00. Three tournapulls were hauling from piles to station 73/00, assisted by 2 push cats and a dozer on the dump.

One turnapull, a carryall scraper, a dnmp truck and a service truck were all idle at the contractors shop. (Sta. 73/00)

#### 4. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The material from the borrow pit left of station 75/00 is of excellent quality. Very little of the expected debris has developed in the pit to date. The turnapulls are able to hanl full loads and the resulting subgrade will be well compacted in shallow layers.

Progress shown to date indicates that considerable additional hauling equipment will be required to complete the grading by Dec. 15 as specified. The contractor has this equipment available at Anchorage and plans to bring it to the project as soon as it can be worked economically.

Items connected with the bridges have been subcontracted to the Munter Construction Company, Inc. Cement for the bridges has been shipped and some arrangements for piling have been made. Apparently the subcontractor plans to accomplish as much work as possible on the piers and abutments this fall.

The contractor plans to place a shallow lift of borrow (1' to 2') over the entire length of the project as soon as possible. This well compacted haul road will assure ready access to all parts of the job after wet weather sets in this fall.

A small craw has been working on the wood stave pipe extensions and on the extensions of box culverts. Four laminated boxes extended to date. Nine wood stave pipes extended and five new metal pipes installed. (Culverts are 7% complete) Very few of necessary pipes are on job.

### 3. WORK IN PROGRESS: .

Two men setting guard stakes at slope stakes Sta. 521.

Three men setting up pumps at Sta. 480 getting set to try a hydraulic operation. (See comments)

A D-7 dozer was hooked to a 12' pull blade at Sta. 418 preparatory to

### 4. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

On July 29 Mr. G. B. Martin, who had three tractors rented to the contractor, pulled all his equipment off the job. This leaves the job a good deal worse off than it has been before. No definite arrangements have been made to date for additional equipment.

No appreciable effort has been expended on the frozen cuts Sta. 435 to Sta. 500 since the last inspection. Frost has receded an average of 1' to 2' over the entire area and the thawed material is so wet that it is almost impossible to operate cat equipment through it. There is no doubt that a good deal of this material will have to be wasted as it contains too much vegetable matter. Apparently a dragline would be the best piece of equipment to use at this time but the contractor does not have one available. As a temporary expedient, pumps have been installed on the Tanana River near Sta. 480 and an attempt will be made to dispose of the waste by hydraulic means.

Since a greater portion of the 1951 construction season has passed without appreciable progress being made, it appears unlikely that the grading specified will be completed satisfactorily during the remainder of this construction season. Progress is therefore reported as unsatisfactory. Following is a tabulation of tests taken in some of the frozen cuts:

### 3. WORK IN PHOGRESS:

The contractor is starting a camp at Donnelly Done. Two buildings have been brought in and two men were working around camp.

A D-S cat and carryall acraper were working in the borrow pit left of Station 424 assisted by a D-S push cat. The material was going into a fill at Sta. 415.

A D-8 dozer was drifting material from the cut at Sta. 235. Three cats were down for repairs.

Only two pipes have been installed to date.

#### 4. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

Progress is shown as unsatisfactory because of slow progress and lack of equipment on the job. It appears unlikely that the percent complete can be brought up to the percent of time elapsed before freezing weather sets in.

The contractor plans to have a dragline in operation on the project by August 10.

No particular difficulty has been experienced to date in the frozen, cuts. The material in these cuts is a sandy loam and dries rapidly in the wind. The contractor keeps it moved out as it thaws and does not allow it to pile up.

During a recent storm water from Darling Creek washed out a portion of the fill which had been placed. The contractor had been warned not to start the fill until Darling Creek could be diverted. He will have to assume the loss.

Investigation is being carried out on a possible source of borrow at Station 910 about 1500' right. If this source proves out it appears that considerable saving in haul will result.

Piling for all four bridges on this project (Separate contract by Alaska Road Commission) have been driven by M. P. Munter Construction Co.

### 4. COMMENTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

Frequent tests taken on the select borrow indicate excellent quality material from the pit right of Sta. 263.

Occasional pockets of mud and muskeg have been encountered in roadway excavation, and since time limitations are not sufficient for daying, most of this material has been wasted.

The planned length of piling at Grouse Creek did not give sufficient bearing and it was necessary to increase the length of all piles in this structure.

Concrete aggregate of good quality is being produced at Mile 18 by a local concern.

During the inspection we met Mr. Axel Osberg. He informed us that steps were being taken to get idle equipment working and to increase the night shift operation.

The increased activity indicated since the last report is evidence that the contractor is taking advantage of the excellent weather prevailing.
