This memorandum is in answer to your inquiry of Kay 19, 1957

The memorandum of May 19, 1967 should be controlling. The "Acceptance of Unreserved Federal Lands for Highway Purposes" dated October 2, 1952 should be construed as an inter-agency transfer of land.

The applicable statutes. Of a bigined provides only for the dedication of a bigined provides along setting lines. As a result, the October 2, 1952 "half section line" dedication should be utilized only on those lands which were transferred to private ownership with the dedication reserved in the State Grant Doed. The executive branch of government cannot by administrative action impose reservations upon deeds which are not set out in the deed or in the applicable statutes.
