ACCEPTANCE OF UNRESERVED FEDERAL  
LANDS FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES

The State of Alaska accepts unreserved public lands for highway purposes as authorized in 14 Stat. 253, 43 USC 932. It is declared that all section and half-section lines in the State of Alaska are public highways. The width of these highways is 50 feet on each side of the section lines and half-section lines. It is further declared that all officially proposed and existing highways on the public domain are 100 feet wide.

The authority to accept this grant is vested in these Departments by Sec. 2, Art. III, Title I, Ch. 152, SLA 1957 and Sec. 19, Ch. 64, SLA 1959.
