> I met with Mr. McVee when I was in Anchorage on Thursday, April 8, and discussed the problem of right-of-way through BLM in remote areas. Of particular interest in our discussion was the problem that we frequently encounter whereby we have an existing right-of-way as established by a PLO. During the relocation of the project to make minor variations from the existing centerline which cause little sliver changes in the right-of-way granted under the PLO.

Mr. McVee indicated that it would be satisfactory for us to show only the right-of-way as related to the new centerline where the right-ofway traversed only public lands and no private surveys were involved. In our transmittal letter we need simply to state that this is the right -of-way the State Department of Highways claims under the applicable PLO.
