COMMISSIONER'S DEED OF VACATION

The GRANTOR, the STATE OF ALASKA, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, whose mailing address is 2301 Peger Road, M.S. 2553, Fairbanks, Alaska 99709-5399, acting under the authority of the Alaska Statutes, Section 19.05.070, conveys, quitclaims and otherwise vacate unto the GRANTEE, *Ahtna, Incorporated whose mailing address is P.O. Box 649, Glennallen, Alaska 99588, all interest of whatsoever nature which it has, in the following described real property:

Parcel X-1

A parcel of land located within Section 17, Township 10 North, Range 5 East, Copper River Meridian, Chitina Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the Old Tok Cutoff highway right of way established by Public Land Order 1613 effective 4/7/58 and conveyed to the State of Alaska under the "Omnibus Act" quitclaim deed dated June 30, 1959 lying southerly and offset 200.00 feet to the right of the centerline for project F-I-OA1-3 (1), Tok Highway Milepost 38 – 51.6 as depicted on the attached plat. Said parcel lies approximately between centerline stations 828+00 and 846+00 and contains approximately 5.180 acres.

Reserving therefrom, a temporary utility easement, 30 feet in width, 15 feet on each side of the existing Copper Valley Telephone line for the benefit of the Copper Valley Telephone Cooperative. CVTC intends to relocate the telephone line to within the DOT&PF highway right of way at some point in the future. At such time that the telephone line is relocated, this temporary utility easement will self terminate.

Parcel X-2

Beginning at the northerly corner common to Lot 3 and Lot 4 of United States Survey 3319, situated in Section 3, Township 9 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian, Alaska, which is the True Point of Beginning for the herein described parcel;

Thence N88°10'00"W along the northerly boundary of said Lot 3 and the existing right-of-way of the Tok Cutoff a distance of 4.62 feet to an angle point of said right-of-way; thence N01°49'00"E along aforementioned right-of-way a distance of 883.79 feet to a point on the section line between Section 3, Township 9 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian and Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian, which point lies East a distance of 1454.55 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 3; thence East along said section line a distance of 69.34 feet to a point; thence departing said section line along a curve to the left which has a radius of 2641.12 feet and whose chord bears \$07°16'51"W, 661.50 feet, an arc distance of 663.24

feet to a point; thence S00°05'12"w a distance of 227.60 feet to a point on northerly boundary of the aforementioned Lot 4; thence N88°10'00"W along said boundary a distance of 8.56 feet to the true point of beginning.

Containing 0.410 acres, more or less.

Parcel X-3

Commencing at the northerly corner common to Lot 3 and Lot 4 of United States Survey 3319, situated in Section 3, Township 9 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian, Alaska; thence N88°10'00"W along the northerly boundary of said Lot 3 and the existing right-of-way of the Tok Cutoff a distance of 4.62 feet to an angle point of said right-of-way; thence N01°49'00"E along aforementioned right-of-way a distance of 883.79 feet to a point on the section line between Section 3, Township 9 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian and Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian, which point lies East a distance of 1454.55 feet from the northwest corner of said Section 3, and which is the True Point of Beginning;

Thence N01°49'00"E along said right-of-way a distance of 475.75 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the right which has a radius of 1104.93 feet and whose chord bears N23°20'01"E, 810.53 feet, an arc distance of 829.90 feet to a point; thence S62°22'33"E a distance of 231.22 feet to a point; thence along a curve to the right which has a radius of 45.49 feet and whose chord bears S18°42'04"W, 32.59 feet, an arc distance of 33.33 feet to a point; thence S39°41'24"W a distance of 20.26 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the left which has a radius of 2596.48 feet and whose chord bears S31°30'21"W, 739.26 feet, an arc distance of 741.78 feet to a point of tangency; thence S23°19'17"W a distance of 23.22 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the left which has a radius of 145.49 feet and whose chord bears S10°00'32"E, 159.89 feet, an arc distance of 169.28 feet to a point; thence along a curve to the left which has a radius of 2641.12 feet and whose chord bears S17°23'51"W, 269.33 feet, an arc distance of 269.45 feet to a point on the aforementioned section line; thence West along said section line a distance of 69.34 feet to the true point of beginning.

Containing 5.049 acres more or less.

AND

Parcel X-5

Commencing at the corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 9 North, Range 4 E of the Copper River Meridian, Alaska and Sections 33 and 34, Township 10 North, Range 4 East of the Copper River Meridian, Alaska; thence East a distance of 1454.55 feet along

the section line between said Sections 3 and 34 to a point on the easterly right-of-way of the Tok Cutoff; thence N01°49'00"E along said right-of-way a distance of 475.75 feet to a point of curvature; thence following said right-of-way along a curve to the right which has a radius of 1104.93 feet and whose chord bears N25°54'58"E, 902.33 feet, an arc distance of 929.49 feet to a point of tangency; thence N50°00'55"E a distance of 1660.60 feet to a point on the ordinary high water line of the Chistochina River and the True Point of Beginning;

Thence N50°00'55"E along said right-of-way a distance of 750.72 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the left which has a radius of 11309.16 feet and whose chord bears N49°02'43"E, 382.96 feet, an arc distance of 382.98 feet to a point; thence N48°04'30"E a distance of 583.49 feet to a point of curvature; thence along a curve to the right which has a radius of 11609.16 feet and whose chord bears N49°16'30"E, 486.25 feet, an arc distance of 486.28 feet to a point; thence N50°28'30"E a distance of 380.71 feet to a point; thence along a curve to the left which has a radius of 11609.16 feet and whose chord bears S46°47'57"W, 598.28 feet, an arc distance of 598.34 feet to a point; thence S45°19'21"W a distance of 2031.53 feet to a point on the ordinary high water line of the Chistochina River; thence N27°17'31"W along said high water line a distance of 174.58 feet to the true point of beginning.

Containing 4.625 acres, more or less.

Note: The purpose of this Vacation document is to release specific portions of the easement for highway purposes established under Public Land Order No. 1613, effective 4/7/58, for the Tok Cutoff (Glenn) Highway. This document does not intend nor does it carry the authority to release any RS-2477, ANCSA 17(b) or other non-PLO access rights of way that may exist, intersect or fall within the described parcels. Therefore, any intersecting non-PLO access rights of way will continue to intersect the Tok Cutoff highway right of way at new locations as defined by the revised right of way boundaries.
