Terms and Conditions of Grant

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Order No. 701 of the Director, Bureau of Land Management, dated July 23, 1964 (29 FR 10526), as amended, a right-of-way, the details of which are shown above, is hereby granted for the public lands involved 1/, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- All valid rights existing on the date of the grant.
- All regulations in 43 CFR 2800 as more specifically set forth in the attached terms and conditions.
- Filing of proof of construction within 10 years from date of the grant.
- Subject to attached standard stipulations and special stipulations which are made a part hereof by reference.

1/ For the purpose of this grant, public domain lands include those reserved or withdrawn for specific purposes, entered, selected, occupied and/or settled, and leased.

SPECIAL STIPULATIONS

- Grantee shall conduct all construction, operation, and maintenance activities with minimum disturbance to vegetation. In areas where heavy equipment would be detrimental under the existing condition, standard hand clearing operations will be used.
- 2. Cut and fill operations shall be held to the very minimum necessary.
- All overburden shall be removed and stockpiled for use in backfill and rehabilitation of cut and fill slopes.
- 4. All portions of the Elliott Highway replaced by the new alignment and no longer used or maintained shall be obliterated, stabilized, and rehabilitated in accordance with Standard Right-of-Way Stipulations B12.
- 5. Within six months of completion of the project, Grantee shall submit to the Authorized Officer a detailed plat describing the new highway right-of-way to be retained and all other existing highway rights-of-way replaced by the new highway that will be retained and maintained by the Grantee.




