Poke, I haven't checked to see if you see if you are back in the office. Hope everything went well and you are once again leaping tall buildings with a single bound! Our Taylor highway mining issue is starting to heat up. While you were out we met with the BLM area manager for the Taylor Highway and were informed that BLM is closely reviewing the title issues that we dredged up because they noted that if the Taylor highway ROW is validly based on PLO 601, that particular PLO closed the 200' highway corridor to all forms of entry including mining. So BLM may be looking at voiding the portion of the claims within the 200' ROW. And then they said that as the claims cannot be bifurcated, the miner would have to choose which portion of the claim to retain if the claim straddled the highway ROW. They would only be able to claim on one side of the highway ROW. They said their mining law adjudicator and solicitors would be reviewing all of this because they recognize that it will directly impact several miners on Jack Wade and would expect a political firestorm to result. I just sent them another email today asking for an update.

Meanwhile Pete and Jason had another conversation with Mr. Kuzmin and were in the process of drafting a permit when we received the attached email two photos showing Kuzmin's operation as of the last couple of days. Jason drafted a proposed typical section (attached) for inclusion in the permit. As you can see from the typical and the photos it would serve to push Kuzmin's operation quite a bit further away from the road. In the event he doesn't understand or accept our direction my question to you is what legal action we can take to enforce our guidelines.

I'm not sure what other assignments you might have on your desk right now but as we talked about the title issues it seemed appropriate for you to continue this assignment. Let me know if you are already booked. Thanks, JohnB

Pete, I see in Jason's text below that he has not yet seen the draft permit from you. Please make this your number 1 priority. JohnB
