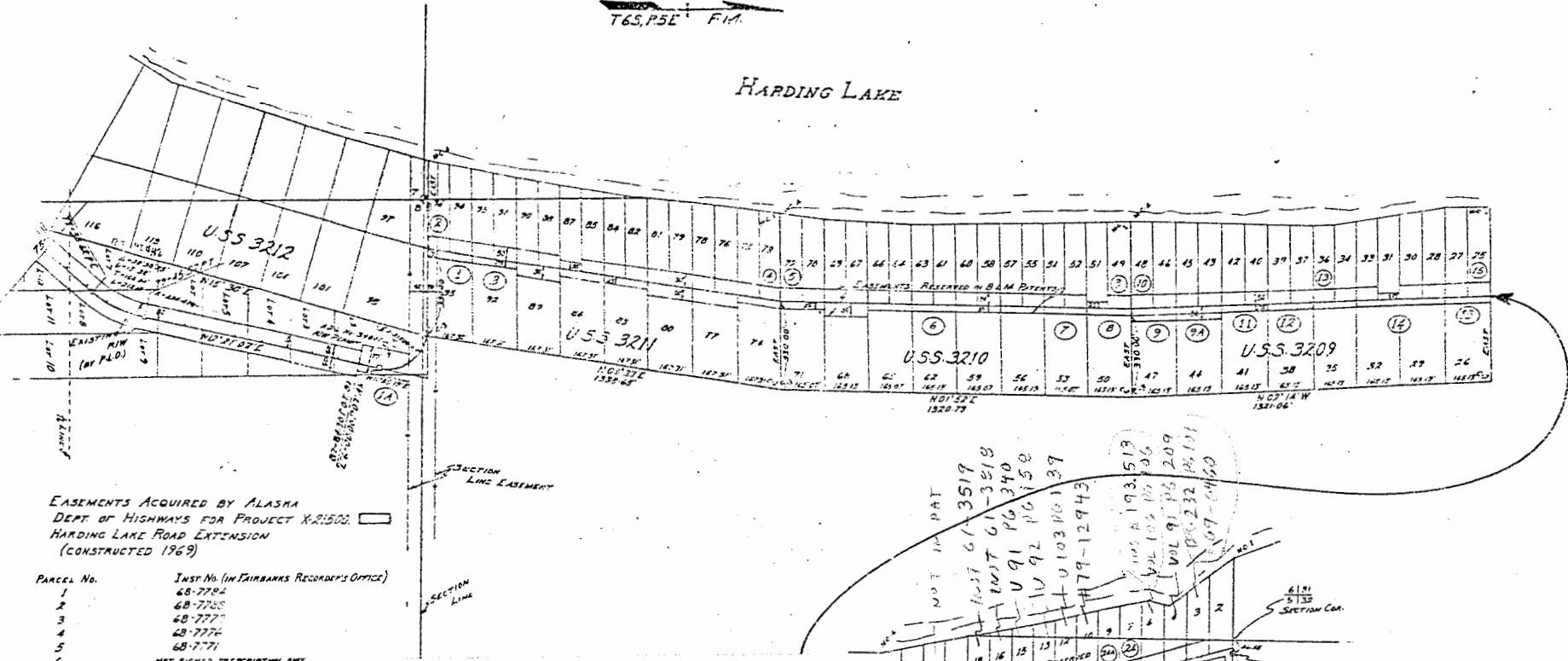

HARDING LAKE

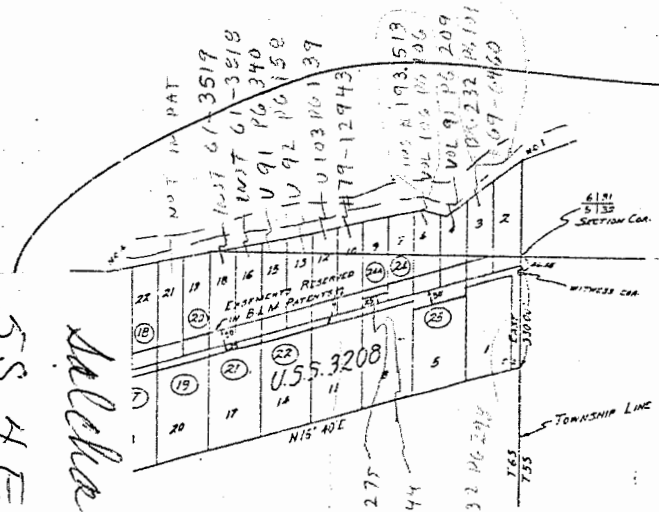
