

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## INTERIM CONVEYANCE

## WHEREAS

## Cook Inlet Region, Inc.

is entitled to a conveyance pursuant to Secs. 14(e) and 22(j) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (43 U.S.C. 1601, 1613(e), 1621(j)), Sec. 12(b)(6) of the act of January 2, 1976 (89 Stat. 1151), and I.C.(2) of the Terms and Conditions for Land Consolidation and Management in the Cook Inlet Area, as clarified on August 31, 1976 (90 Stat. 1935), for the surface and subsurface estates in the following described lands:

Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska (Unsurveyed)

T. 1 S., R. 2 E. Secs. 26 and 27.

Containing approximately 1,280 acres.

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, unto the above-named corporation the surface and subsurface estates in the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said estates with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said corporation, its successors and assigns, forever.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING TO THE UNITED STATES from the lands so granted:

Pursuant to Sec. 17(b) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)), the following public easement, referenced by easement identification number (EIN) on the easement map attached to this document, copies of which will be found in case file F-80201, is reserved to the United

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States. All easements are subject to applicable Federal, State, or Municipal corporation regulation.

60 Foot Road - The uses allowed on a sixty (60) foot wide road easement are: travel by foot, dogsleds, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheel vehicles, small and large all-terrain vehicles, track vehicles, four-wheel drive vehicles, automobiles, and trucks.

(EIN 1 C4, D1, D4) An easement thirty (30) feet in width for an existing road, locally known as Repp Road, along the south section lines of Secs. 26 and 27, T. 1 S., R. 2 E., Pairbanks Meridian, easterly and westerly to public land. The uses allowed are those listed above for a sixty (60) foot wide road easement.

THE GRANT OF THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED ESTATE IS SUBJECT TO:

- Issuance of a patent after approval and filing by the Bureau of Land Management of the official plat of survey confirming the boundary description and acreage of the lands hereinabove granted;
- 2. Valid existing rights therein, if any, including but not limited to those created by any lease (including a lease issued under Sec. 6(g) of the Alaska Statehood Act of July 7, 1958 (48 U.S.C. Ch. 2, Sec. 6(g))), contract, permit, right-of-way, or easement, and the right of the lessee, contractee, permittee, or grantee to the complete enjoyment of all rights, privileges, and benefits thereby granted to him. Further, pursuant to Sec. 17(b)(2) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971 (43 U.S.C. 1601, 1616(b)(2)) (ANCSA), any valid existing right recognized by ANCSA shall continue to have whatever right of access as is now provided for under existing law;

A right-of-way, F-12505, for pipeline purposes, located in Secs. 26 and 27, T. 1 S., R. 2 E., Fairbanks Meridian, granted to the Amerada Hess Corporation, ARCO Pipeline Company, Bxxon Pipeline Company, Mobil Alaska Pipeline Company, Phillips Petroleum Company, Sohio Pipeline Company and Union Alaska Pipeline Company, their successors and assigns, by the Agreement and Grant dated January 23, 1974, as modified April 27, 1979, pursuant to Section 28 of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 185), as amended by Public Law 93-153 (87 Stat. 576), on November 16, 1973.
