This court permanently enjoins Trapper Killsmany from filing or attempting to file, directly or through the services of others, any financing statements, notices of indebtedness, claims or purported liens, of whatever nature, either with the State of Alaska, Department of Natural Resources, any federal agency, or any other state or local debt registry or any private registry or clearinghouse of debt information, without first obtaining leave of this Court authoring such effort.
