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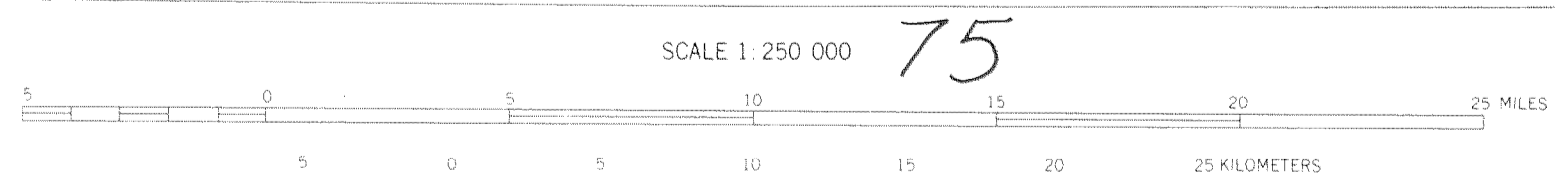

10,000 METER UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR GRID TICKS, ZONE 3 SHOWN IN BLUET.

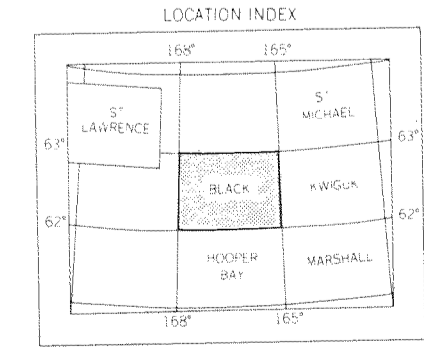
